SUBJECT: GRANT APPLICATION: ALASKA EARLY INTERVENTION
HEARING RESOURCE GRANT

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to submit the Alaska Early Intervention Hearing Resource grant application for the 2001-2002 school year. The total budget amount for this grant application is \$167,734.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The purpose of the Alaska Early Intervention Hearing Resource (AEIHR) is to provide appropriate early educational services to families with children between the ages of birth and three years who live in the state of Alaska and who have a hearing loss or are at high risk for a hearing loss. A part of the Alaska State School for Deaf and Hard of Hearing (ASSDHH), the primary service of AEIHR is family support as early as possible on behalf of hearing impaired infants, in order to achieve minimization or prevention of developmental delays resulting from hearing loss. This includes a strong family training model.

A requirement of the grant is for the District to provide in-kind services. A total of \$77,849 is spent for in-kind contribution. This includes facilities support and instructional support from the ASSDHH state contract.
