SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR
OCTOBER 31, 2001

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for October 31, 2001 is attached. The total active enrollment at the end of October was 49,543, an increase of 120 students from the October 31, 2000 total of 49,423. Table 1 compares the membership on October 31, 2001 with the totals from October 31, 2000.

The October 31, 2001 total of 49,543 was 133 less than the beginning of the year September 30, 2001 total of 49,676. This decrease can be compared against a decline of 97 students for the same time period during the 2000-2001 school year, and an average decline of 150 for the 10-year historical average since the 1992-93 school year.

The listing of elementary and secondary schools at or above 120 percent of program capacity is attached. There is one elementary school, Sand Lake, at or above 120 percent of program capacity. There are no secondary schools or programs at or above 120 percent of capacity. SAVE I was deleted from the secondary listing for October.

Capacities shown in the attachments are based on ASD capacity calculations. Effective with next month's report, the District will be using the EED capacities for its capacity analysis and reporting. The attached spreadsheet provides a comparison of current ASD capacity and the corresponding EED capacity for each school. The November end-of-month report will reflect these EED capacities.
