SUBJECT: AWARD OF CONTRACT: BARTLETT HIGH SCHOOL SKYLIGHT
REPLACEMENT

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to award a contract for the Bartlett High School Skylight Replacement to Gamble Construction Company, Inc. for the amount of \$365,000, and not accept any unit prices.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The scope of work for this project includes removal of the existing leaking skylight above "Main Place" at Bartlett High School and installation of a new replacement skylight. Construction is scheduled to start June 2002 and to be completed prior to school opening in 2002.

A solicitation for bids for the Bartlett High School Skylight Replacement was issued on December 19, 2001. Six bids were received on January 31, 2002 (Attachment A). The low responsive bid was submitted by Gamble Construction Company, Inc in the amount of \$365,000 (Attachment B).

Gamble Construction Company, Inc. has completed all the standard requirements, by providing Payment and Performance bonds and necessary insurance documentation. Gamble Construction Company, Inc. has had recent successful experience with the Anchorage School District on the Girdwood School Roofing Project.
