SUBJECT: ALASKA ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL BOARDS' RESOLUTIONS

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board adopt the Association of Alaska School Board's (AASB) 2002 Belief Statements and Core Resolutions including the changes and additions proposed by the School Board (Attachment A).

Suggested Anchorage School Board proposed resolutions and amendments are highlighted in the table of contents and within the document.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Legislative subcommittee of the Anchorage School Board met several times over the past month to consider changes and additions to the AASB 2002 Belief Statements and Core Resolutions proposed by members of the Anchorage School Board and the District administration. The attached document reflects these changes and additions.

At its annual meeting in November, AASB will adopt its 2002 Belief Statements and Core Resolutions. The belief statements and resolutions will form the basis for AASB's legislative program for the 1st Session of the 23rd Alaska State Legislature, which begins in January.

AASB will only consider recommendations for changes to its 2001 Belief Statements and Core Resolutions, which are formally adopted by a school board.
