PERTINENT FACTS:

The Anchorage School Board has established one advisory committee to the School Board. This committee is the Minority Education Concerns Committee (MECC), whose primary purpose is to advise the School Board and the Superintendent on a regular basis regarding 1) the educational program as it relates to the education of minority students K-12 Districtwide; 2) citizen involvement in school activities on minority educational issues; 3) specific minority community concerns; and 4) such matters with respect to the District-at-large as may be identified by the School Board or the Superintendent.

Interviews were held on June 24 and August 5, 2003. Jeff Friedman, School Board representative to the MECC; William Johnson, MECC Chair; Atisa Logo, MECC Vice-Chair; Margo Bellamy, EEO Officer; and Jan Christensen, Assistant Superintendent for Instruction, made up the interview committee. The recommended candidates possess personal skills and varied backgrounds that would complement the committee and advance its mission.

There are two open positions remaining and the Committee intends to interview additional candidates before the end of August.
