SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF CONTINUATION GRANT AWARD: HIV
PREVENTION - RARE-T

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to accept an HIV/AIDS prevention RARE-T continuation grant in the amount of \$18,000 from the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services. This one-year grant supports an established District peer education program for HIV/AIDS prevention.

PERTINENT FACTS:

In April 2003, the Anchorage School District (ASD) Health and Physical Education Program submitted to the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services a continuation grant application for the Reduce AIDS Risk Effectively in Teens (RARE-T) HIV/AIDS peer education project.

The grant has been awarded to support on-going training of students and staff advisors, dissemination of the program through classroom presentations in ASD middle schools and high schools, release time for advisors to attend student presentations, and the development of health promotion materials.
