25 Year History

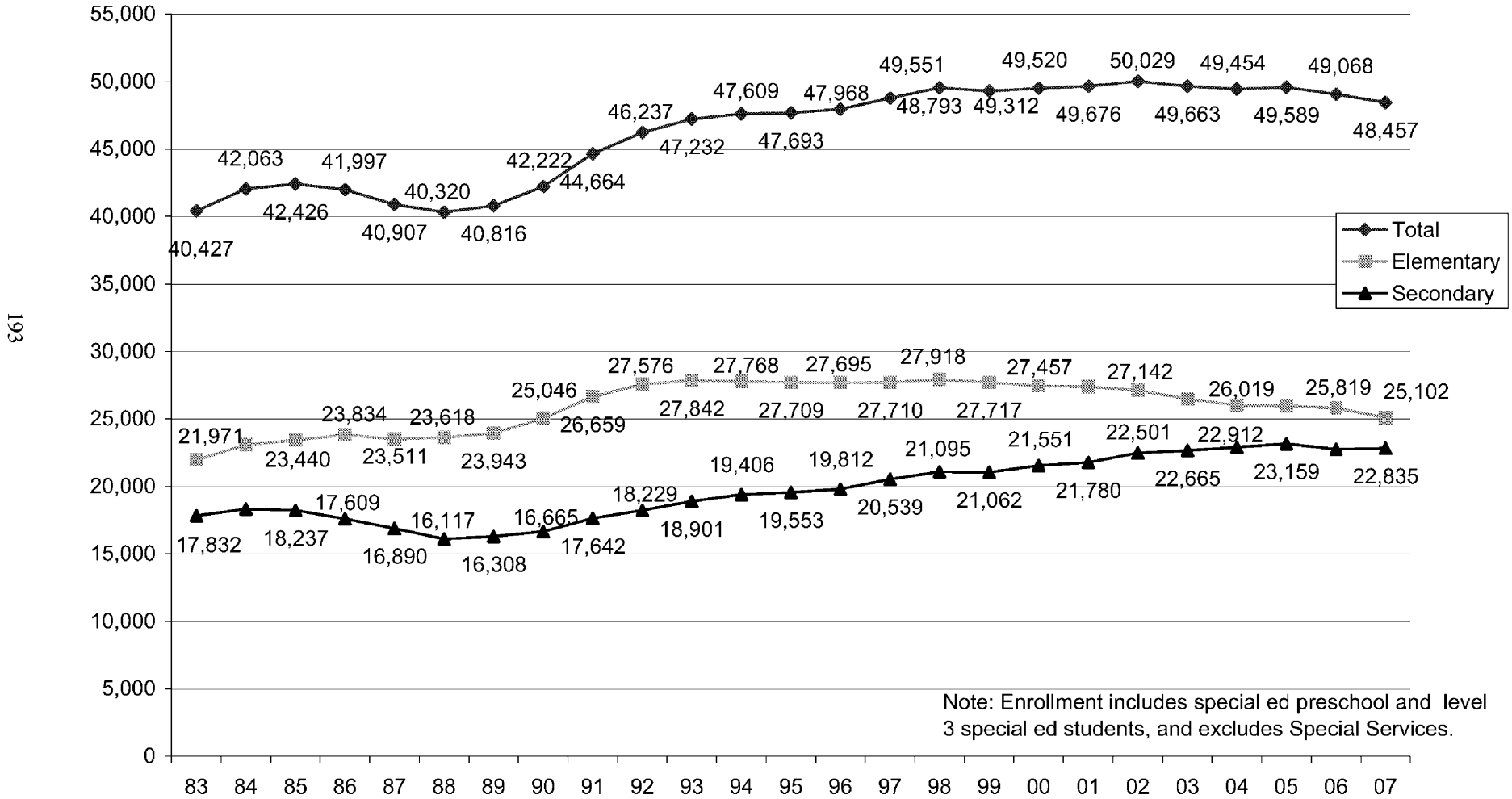
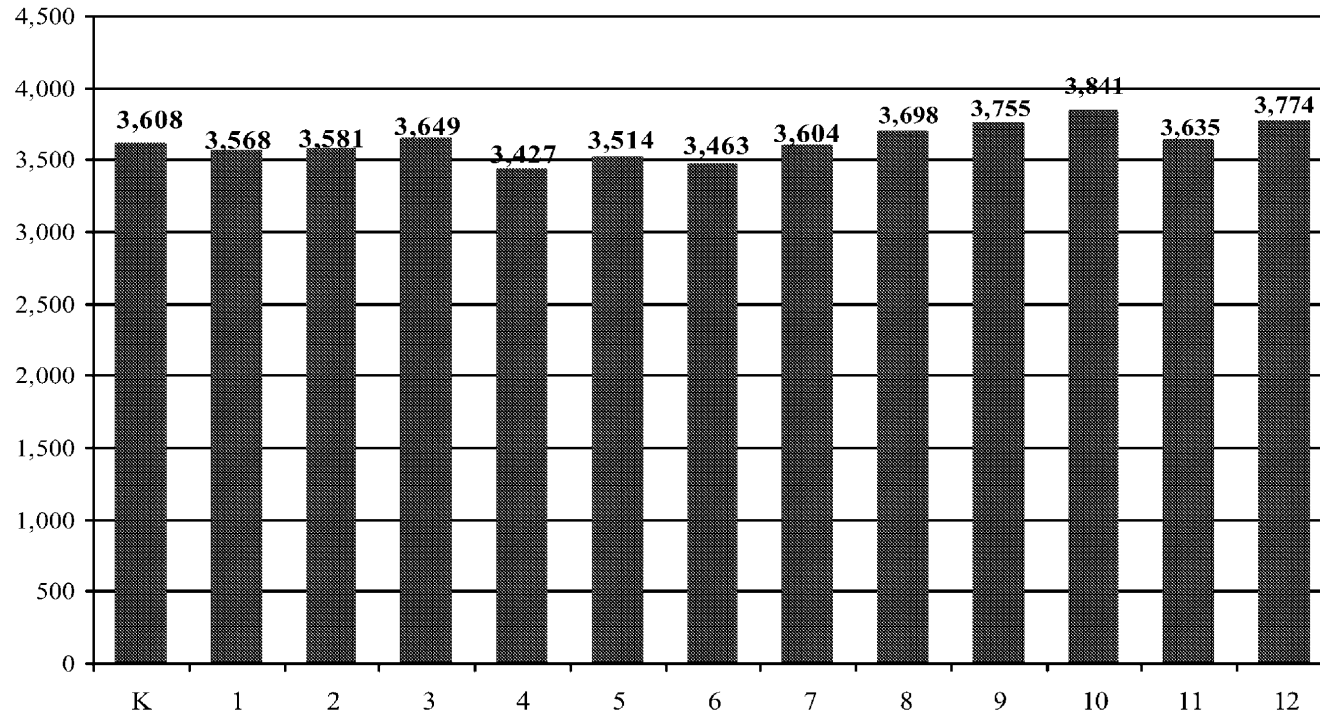

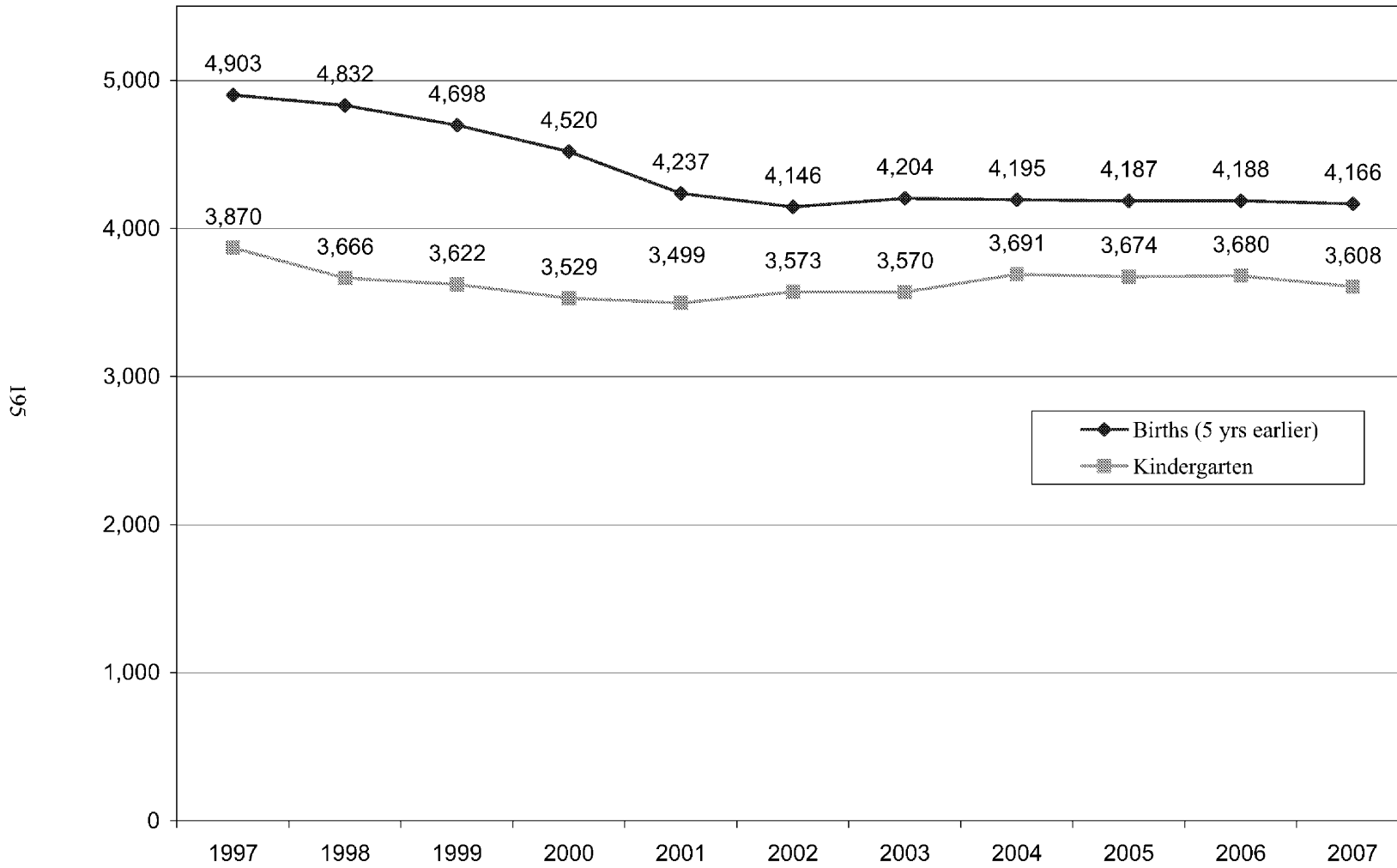
Grades K-12 Membership September 28, 2007

Ten Year History of Kindergarten Enrollment and Births (5 Years Earlier)

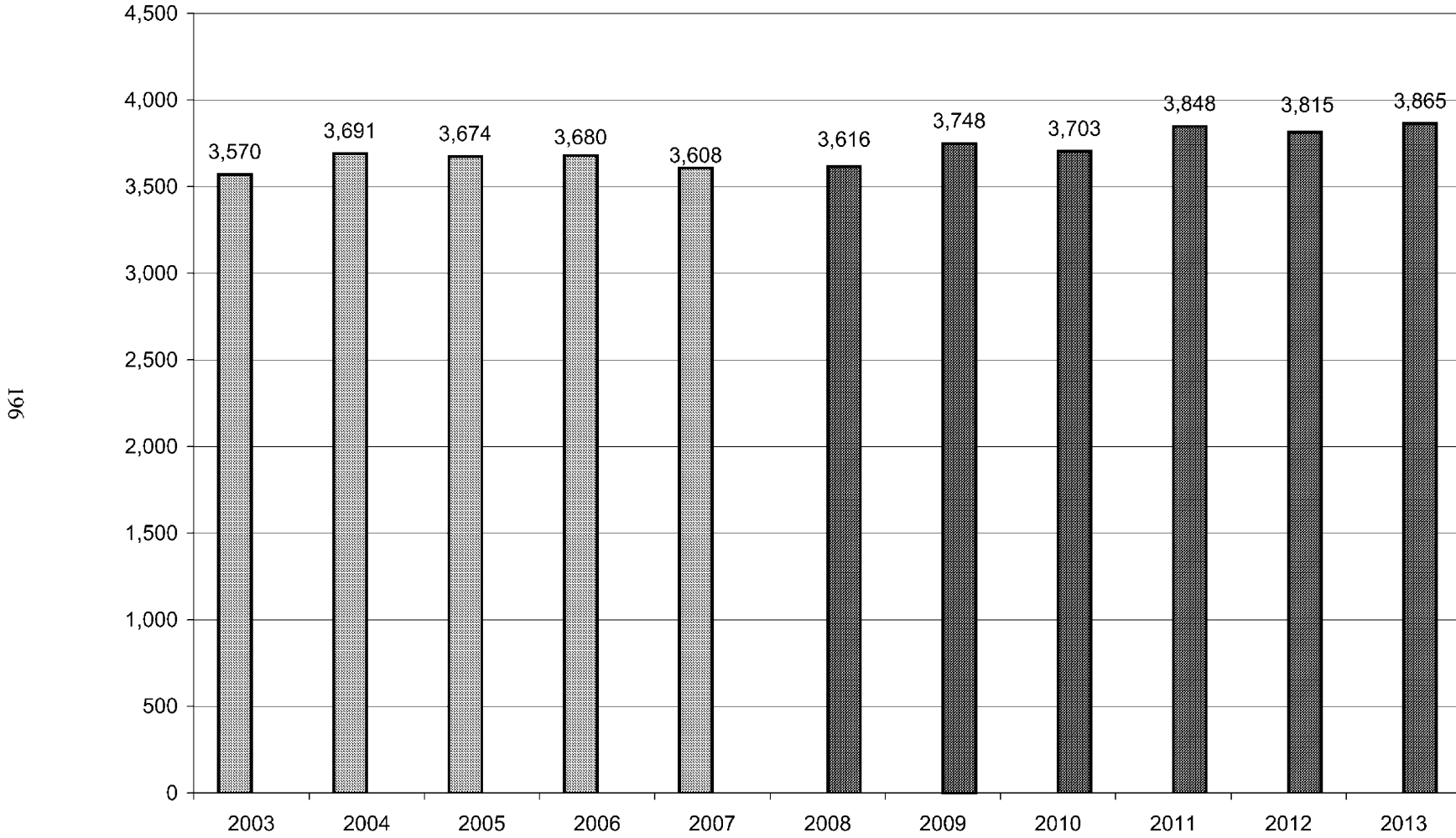

Kindergarten Enrollment

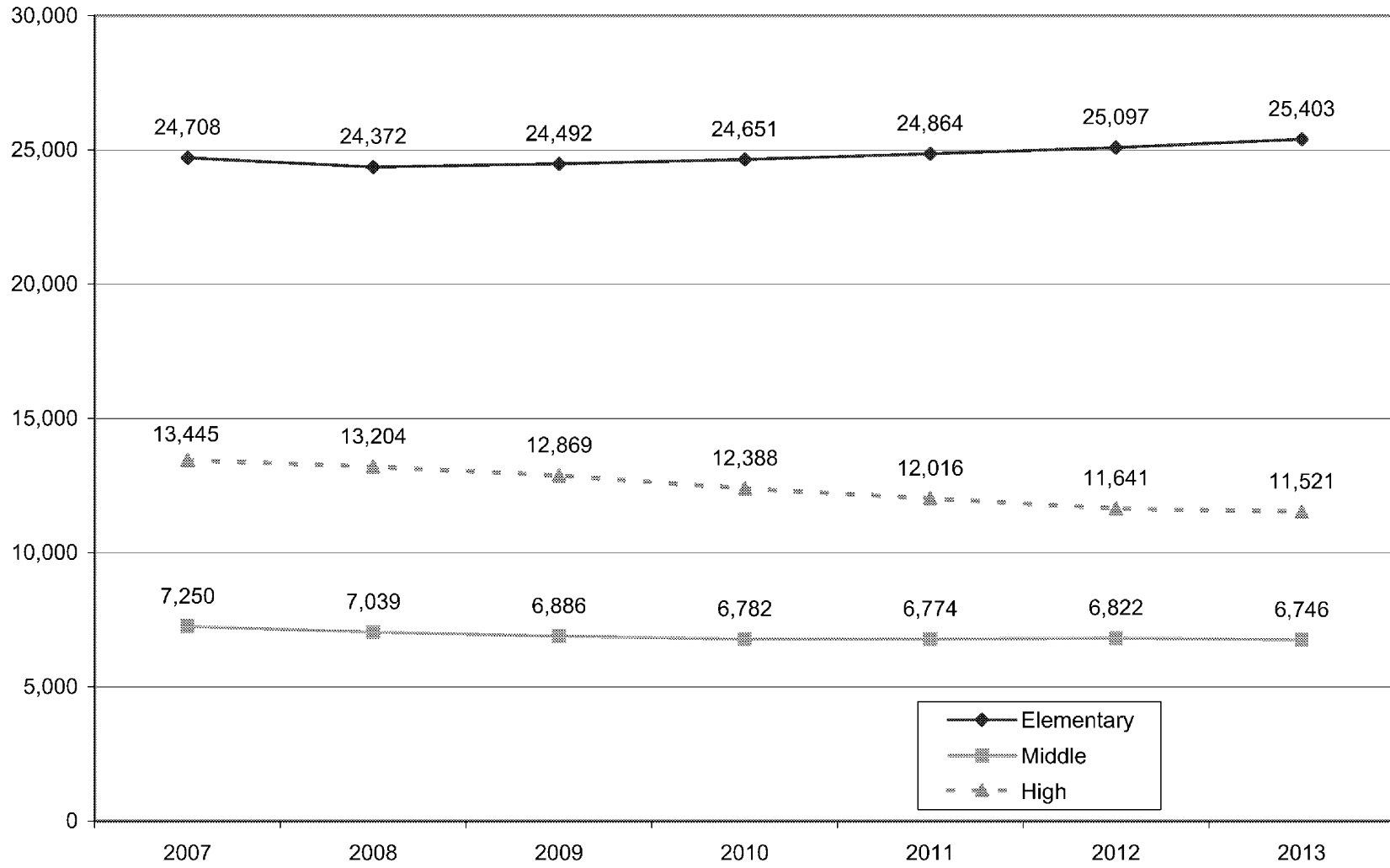
■ Historical ■ Projected

Projected Total Membership 2008-2013

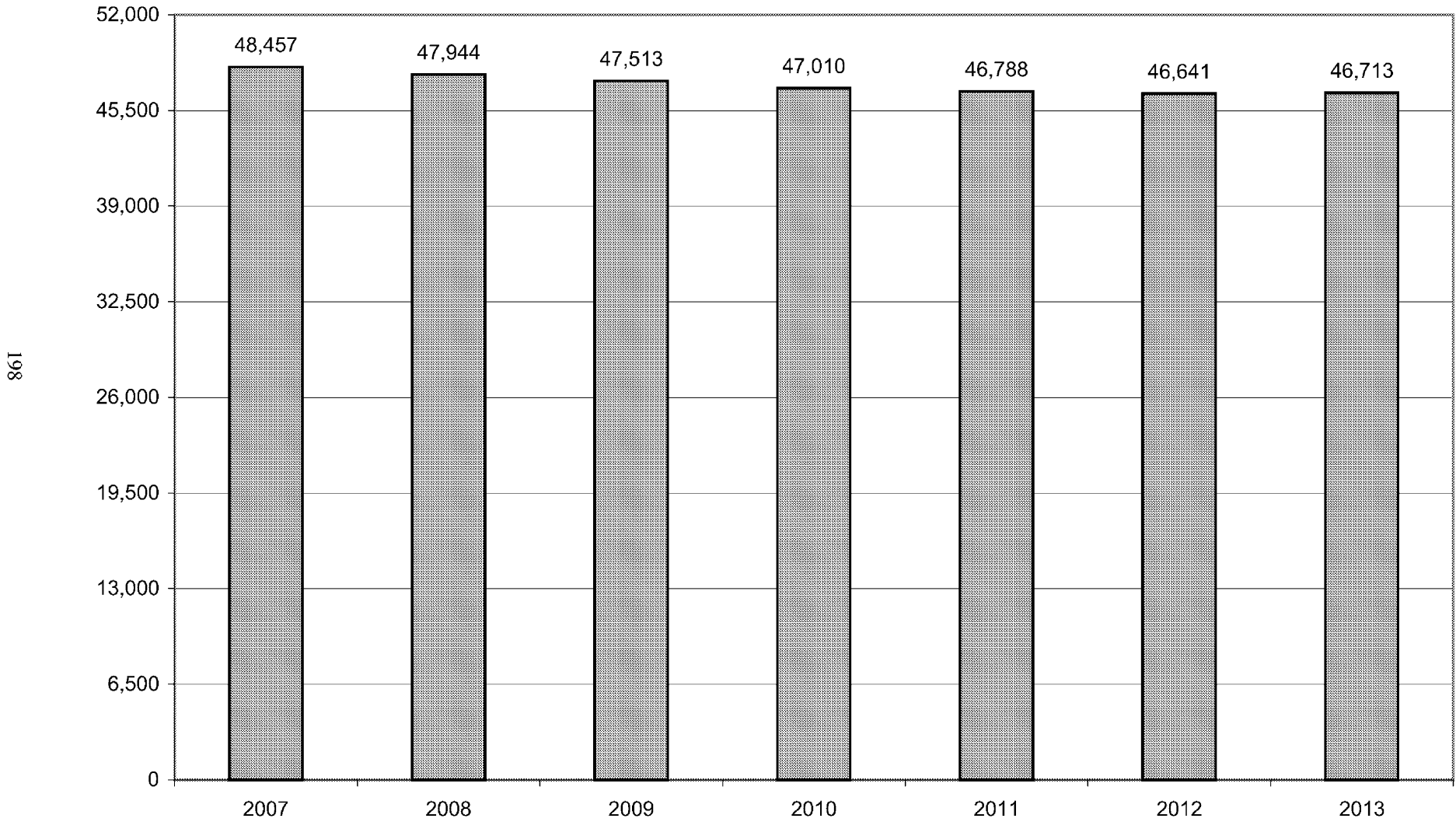

White and Ethnic Minority Populations Membership History

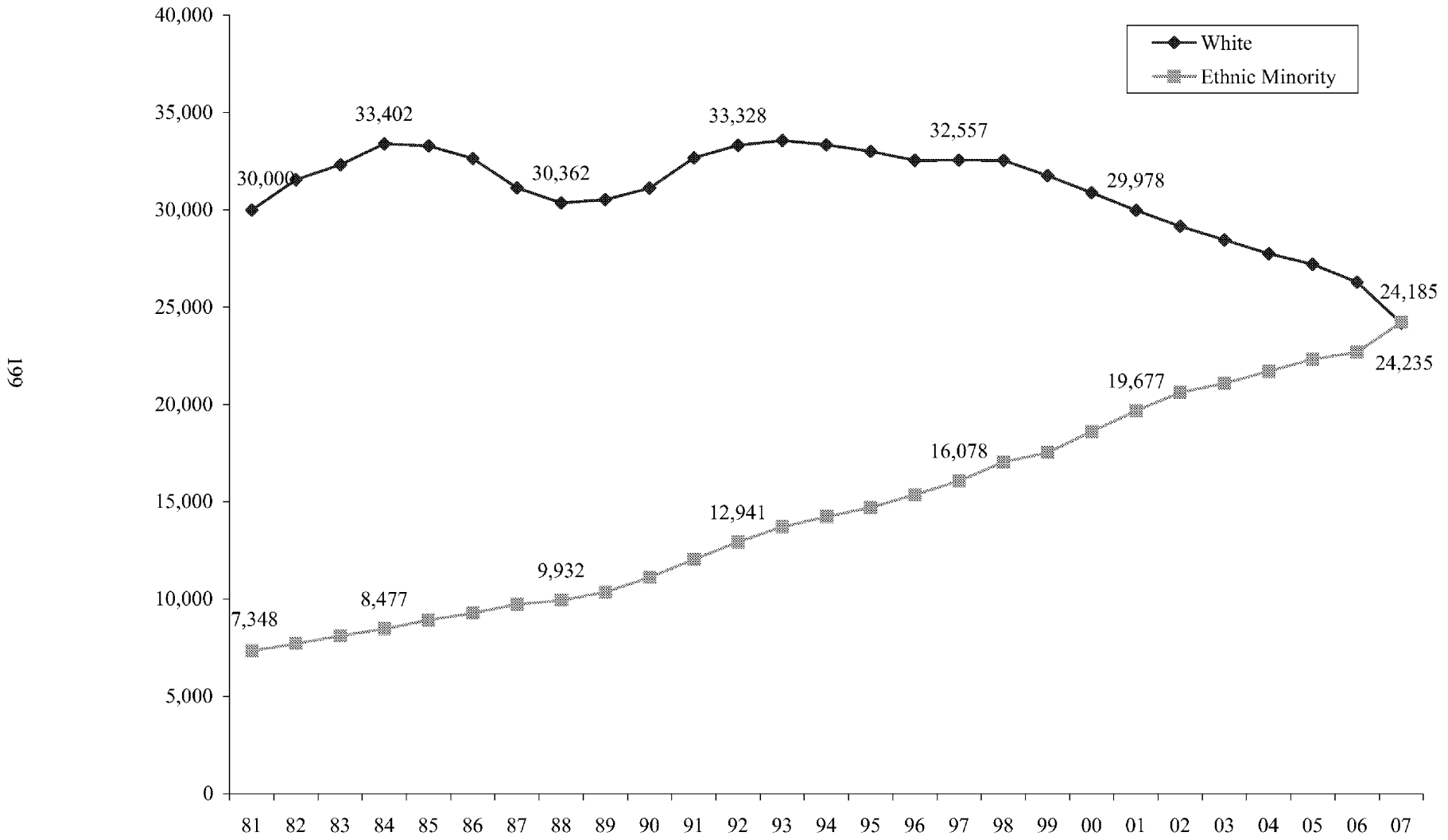
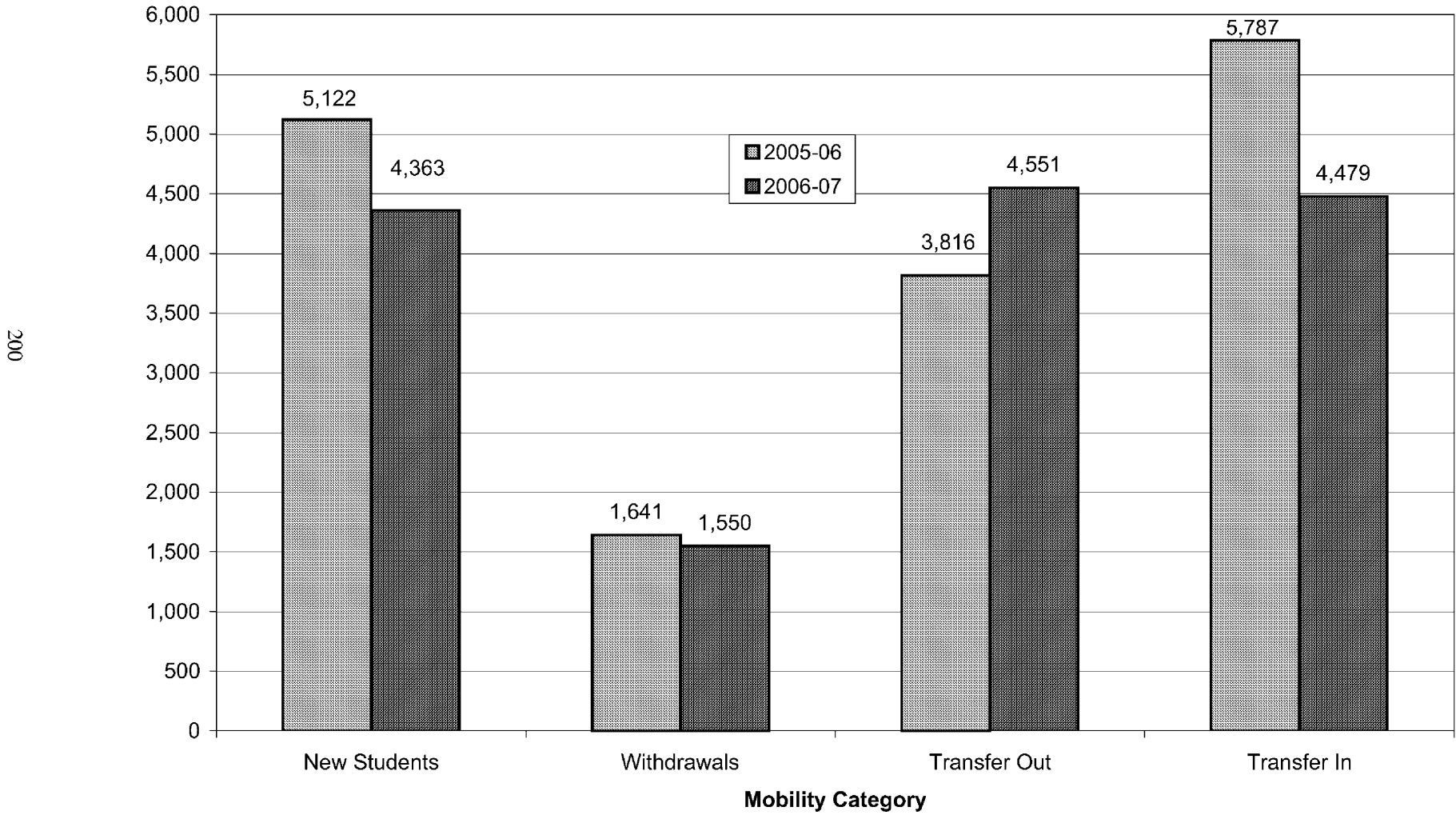


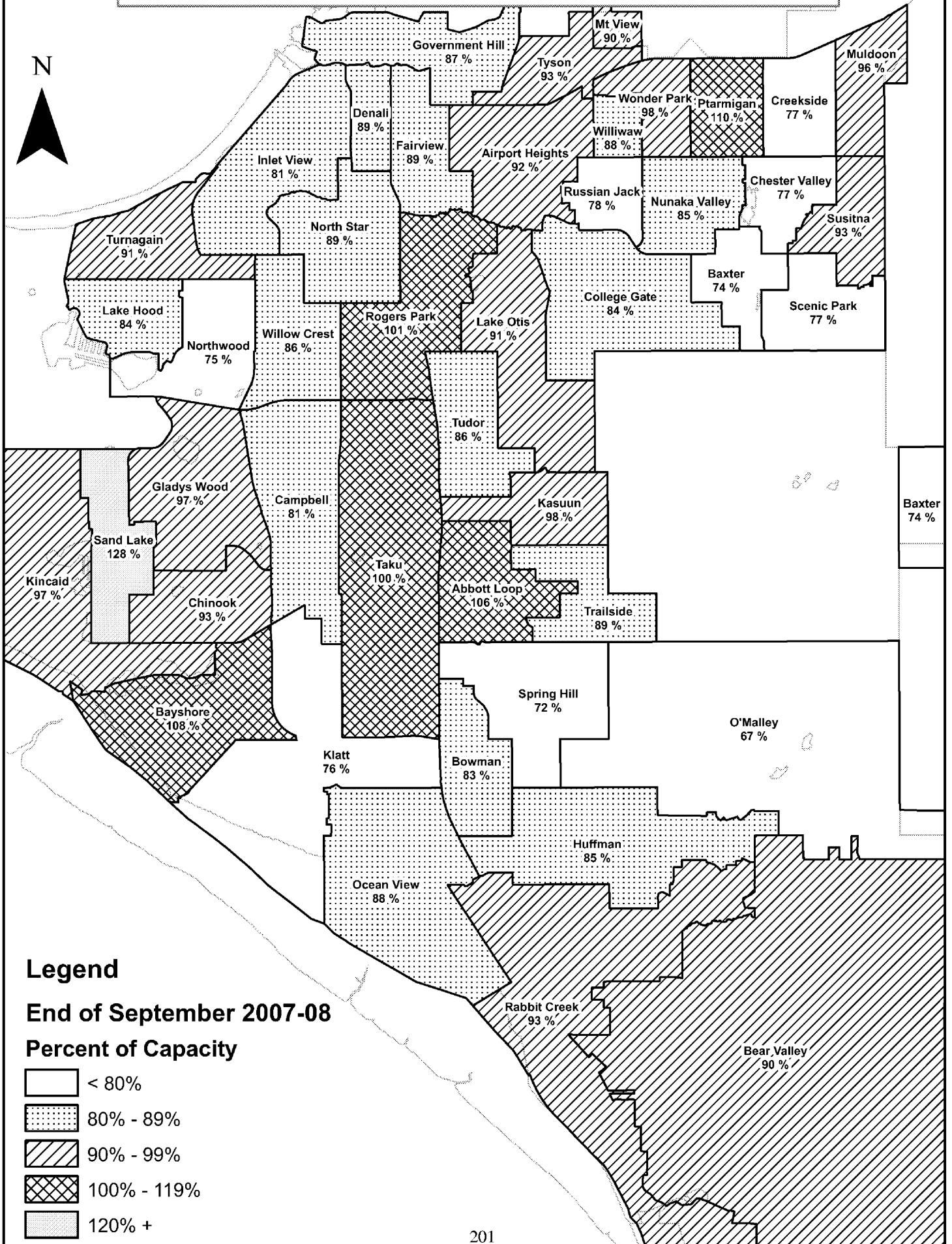

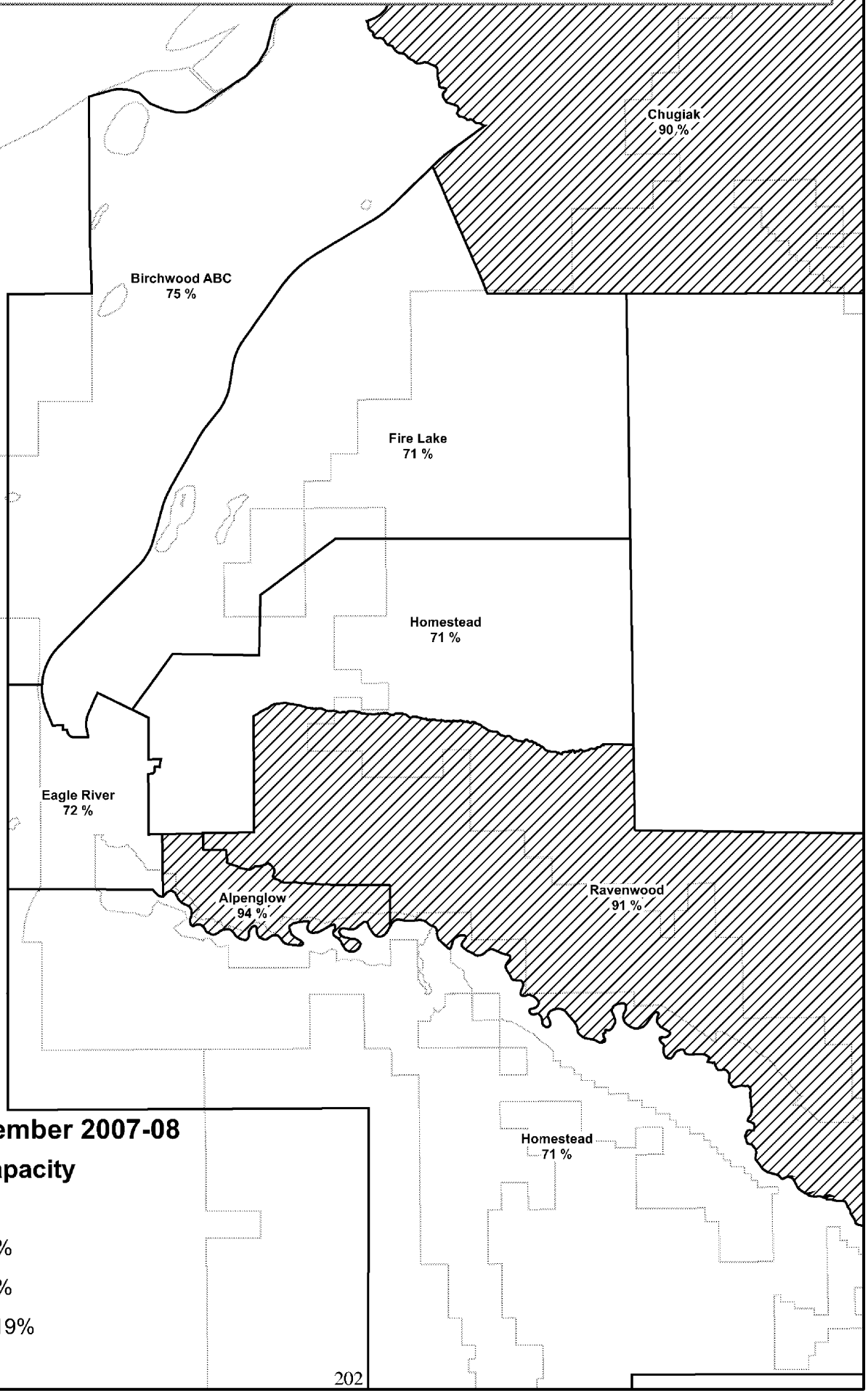





Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak Elementary Attendance Areas



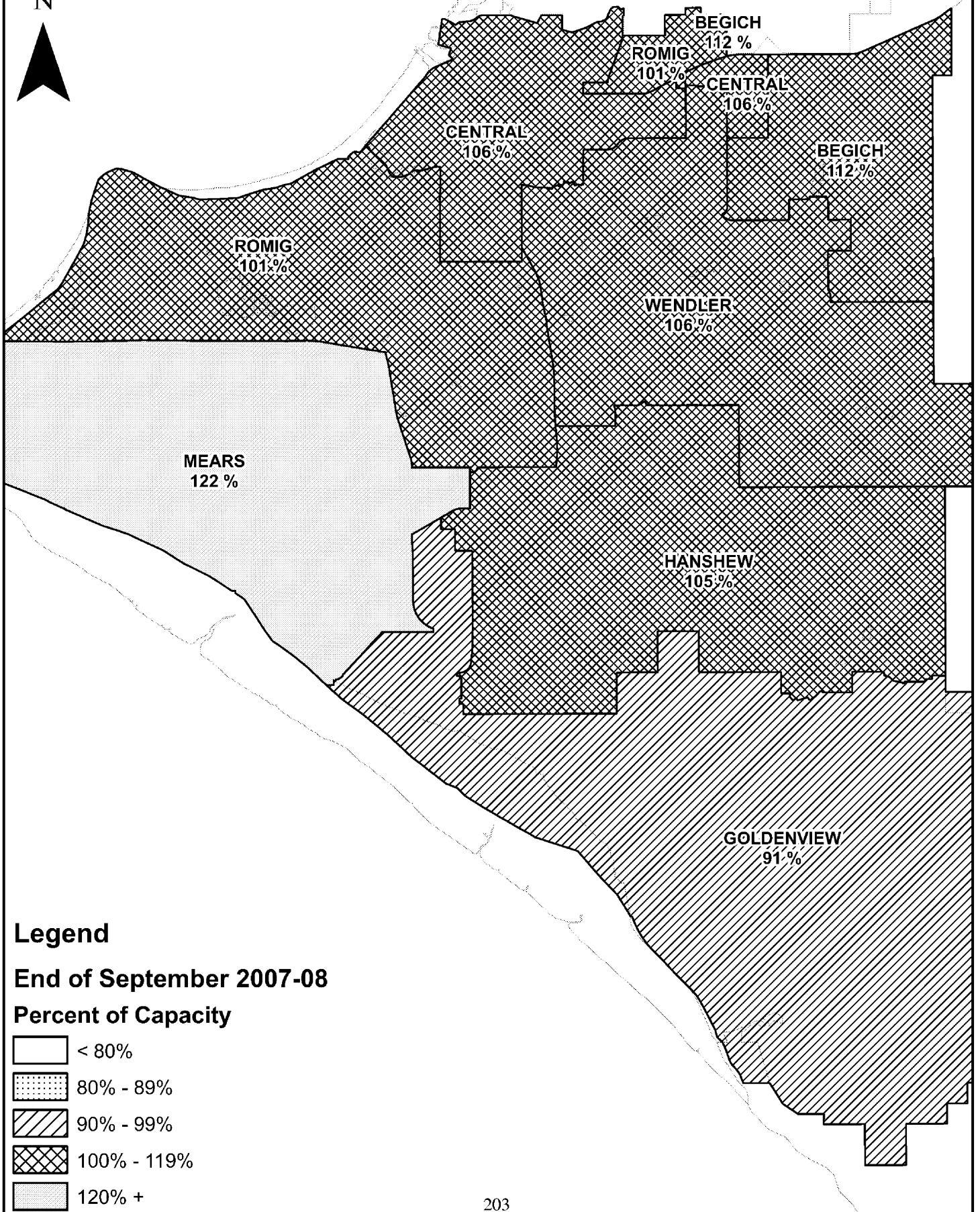






Percent of Capacity by Middle Attendance Areas

Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak Middle Attendance Areas









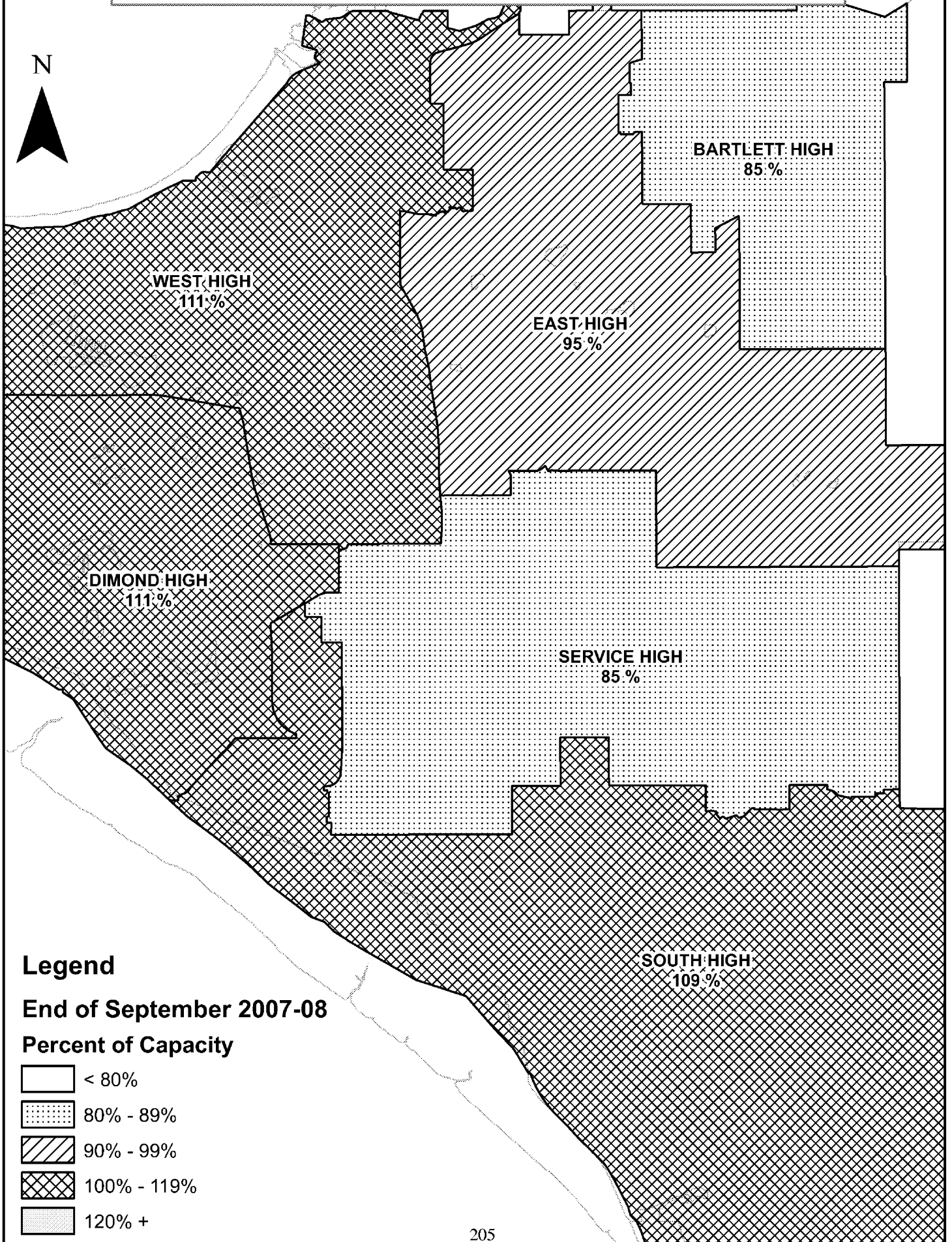






Percent of Capacity by High School Attendance Areas

Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak High School Attendance Areas






