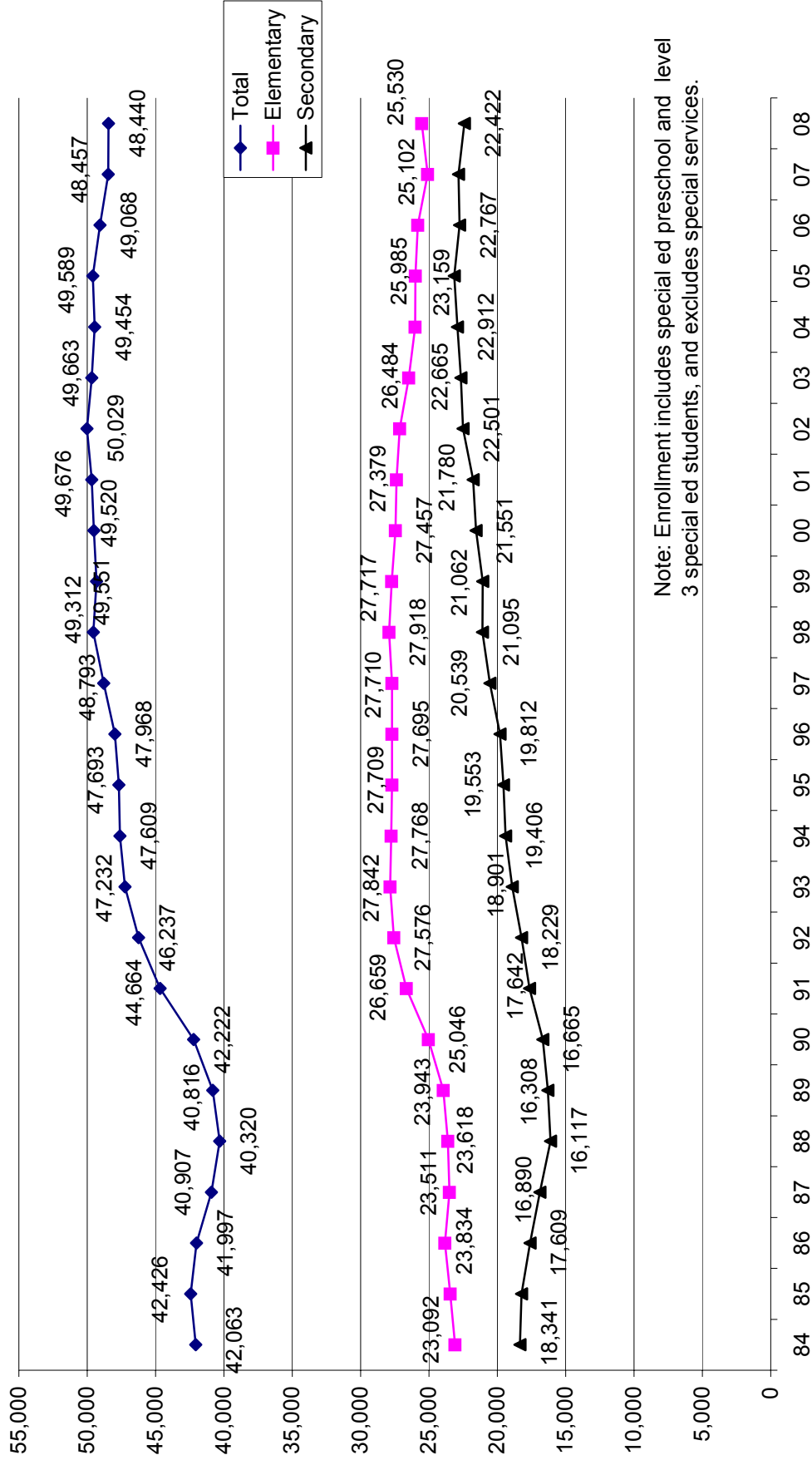

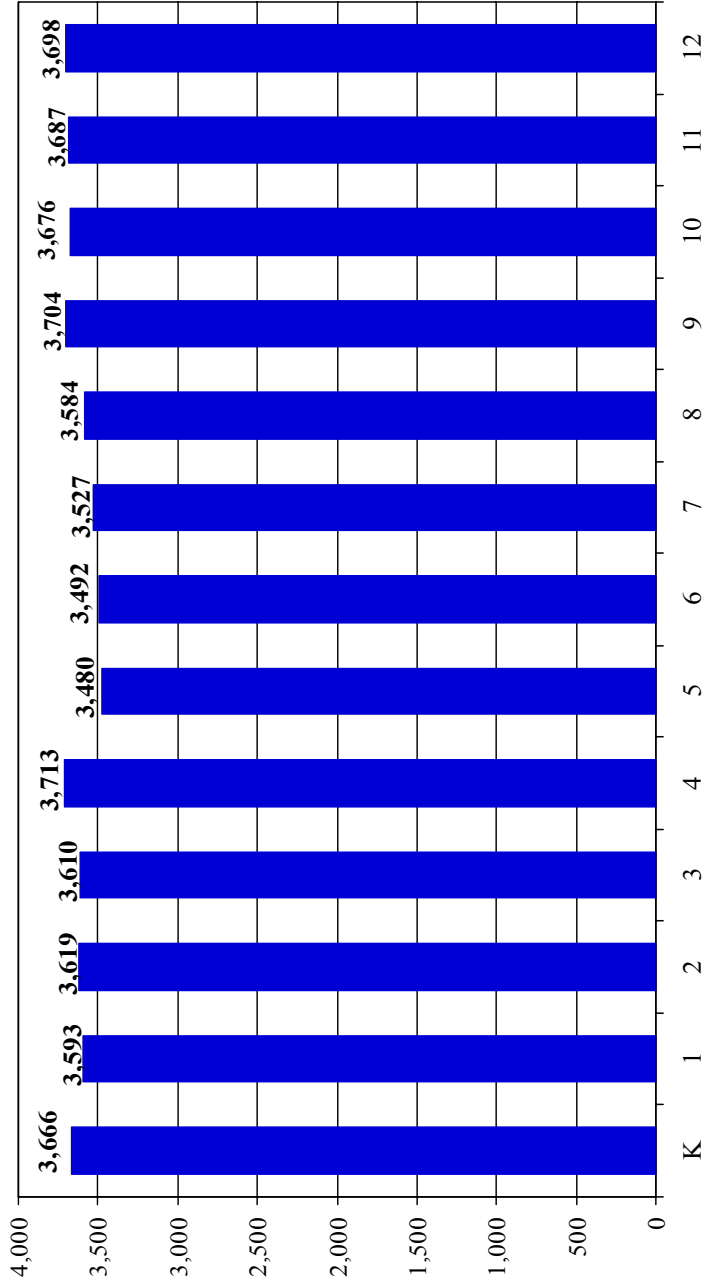
**Student Membership

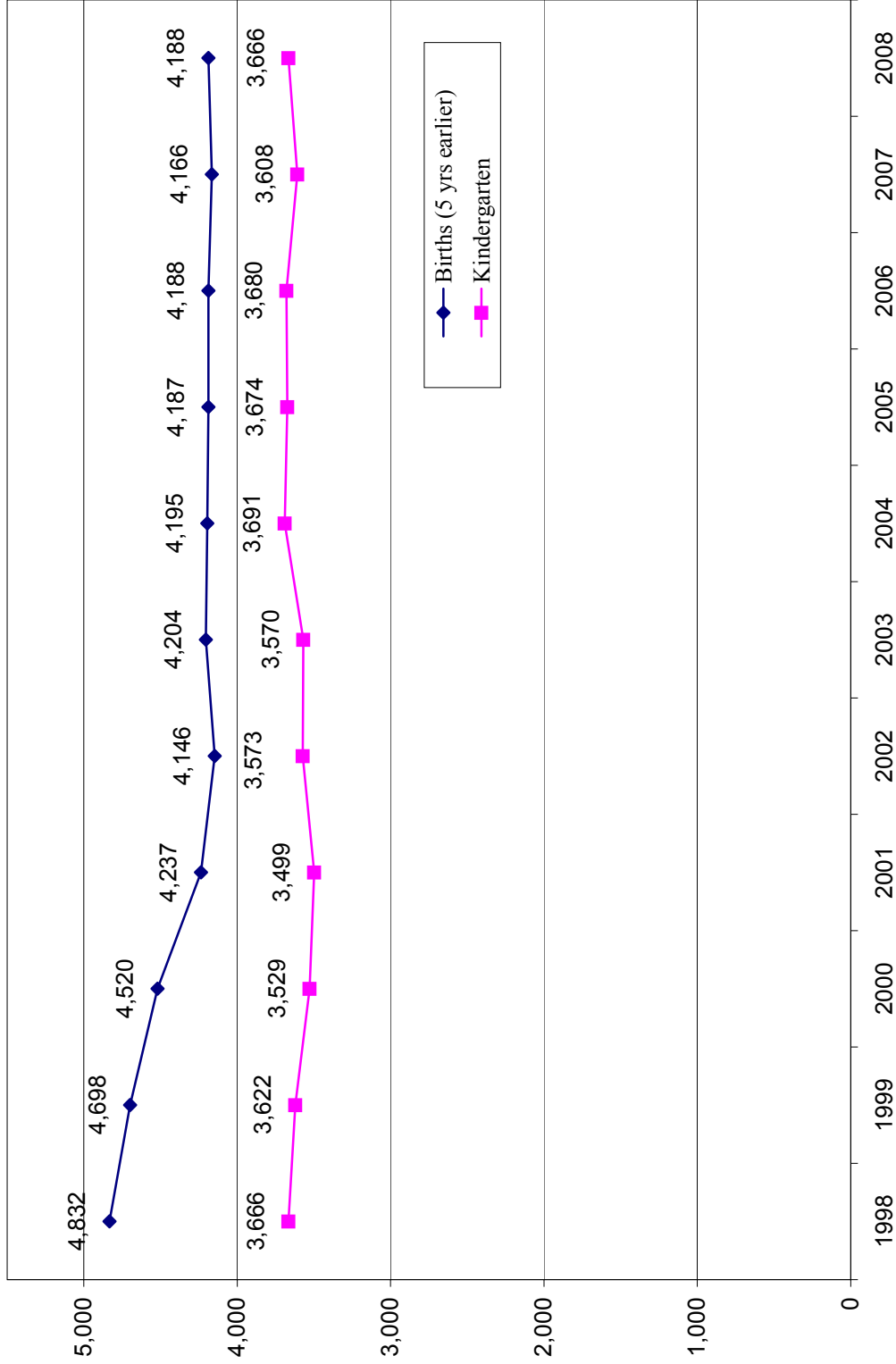
**Grades K-12 Membership September 30, 2008**

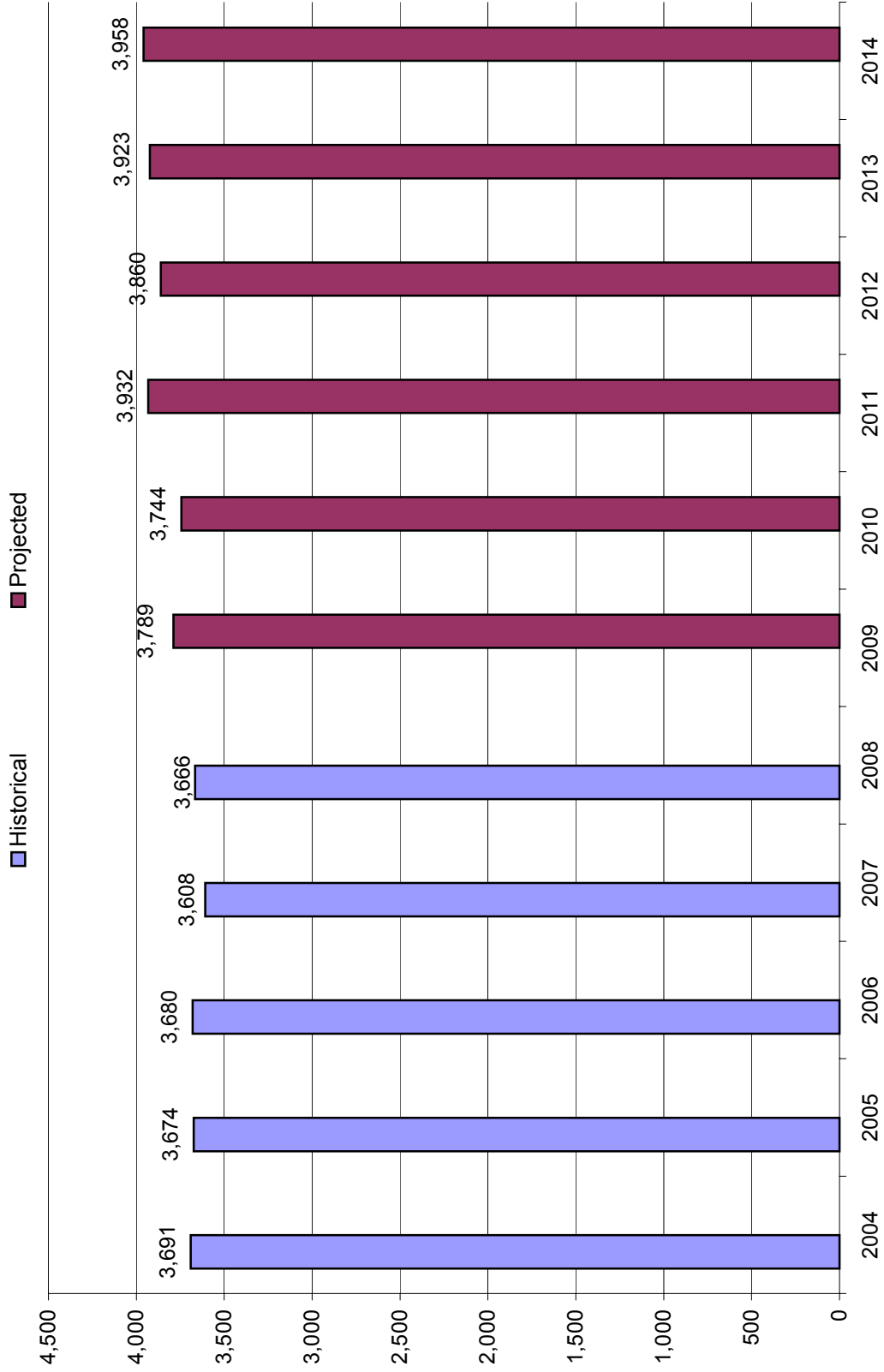
Ten Year History of Kindergarten Enrollment and Births (5 Years Earlier)

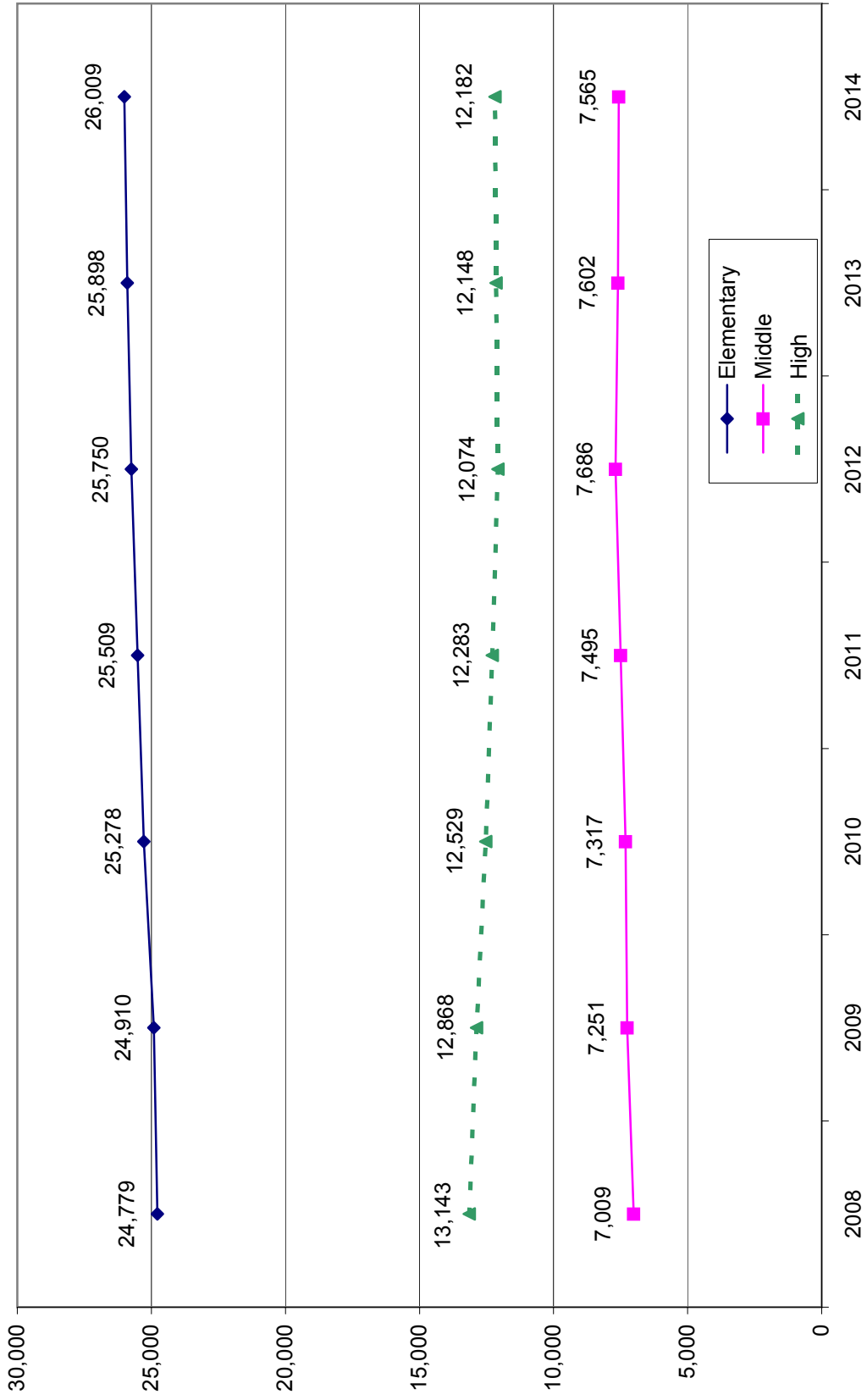
### Kindergarten Enrollment

Projected Total Membership 2009-14

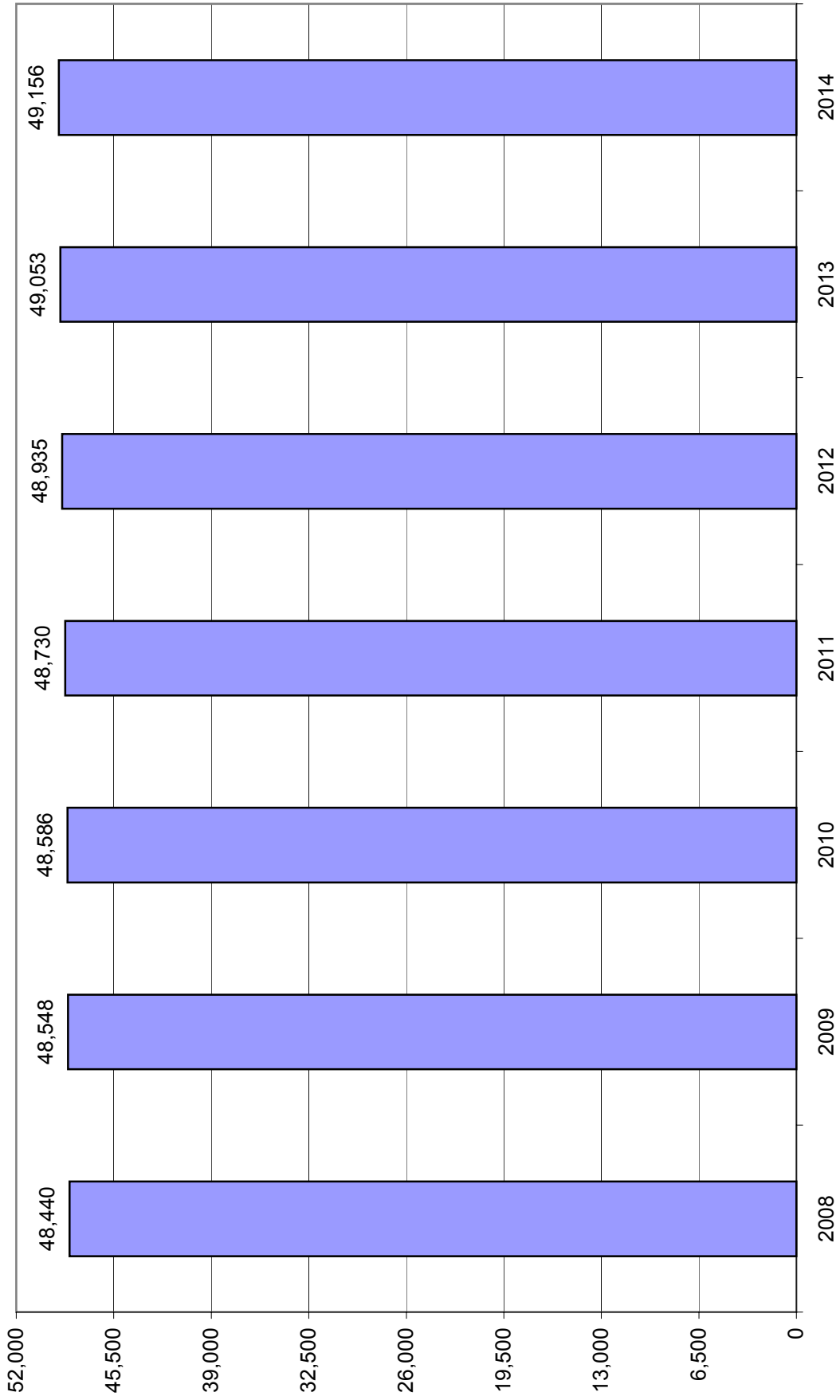

### White and Diverse Populations Membership History

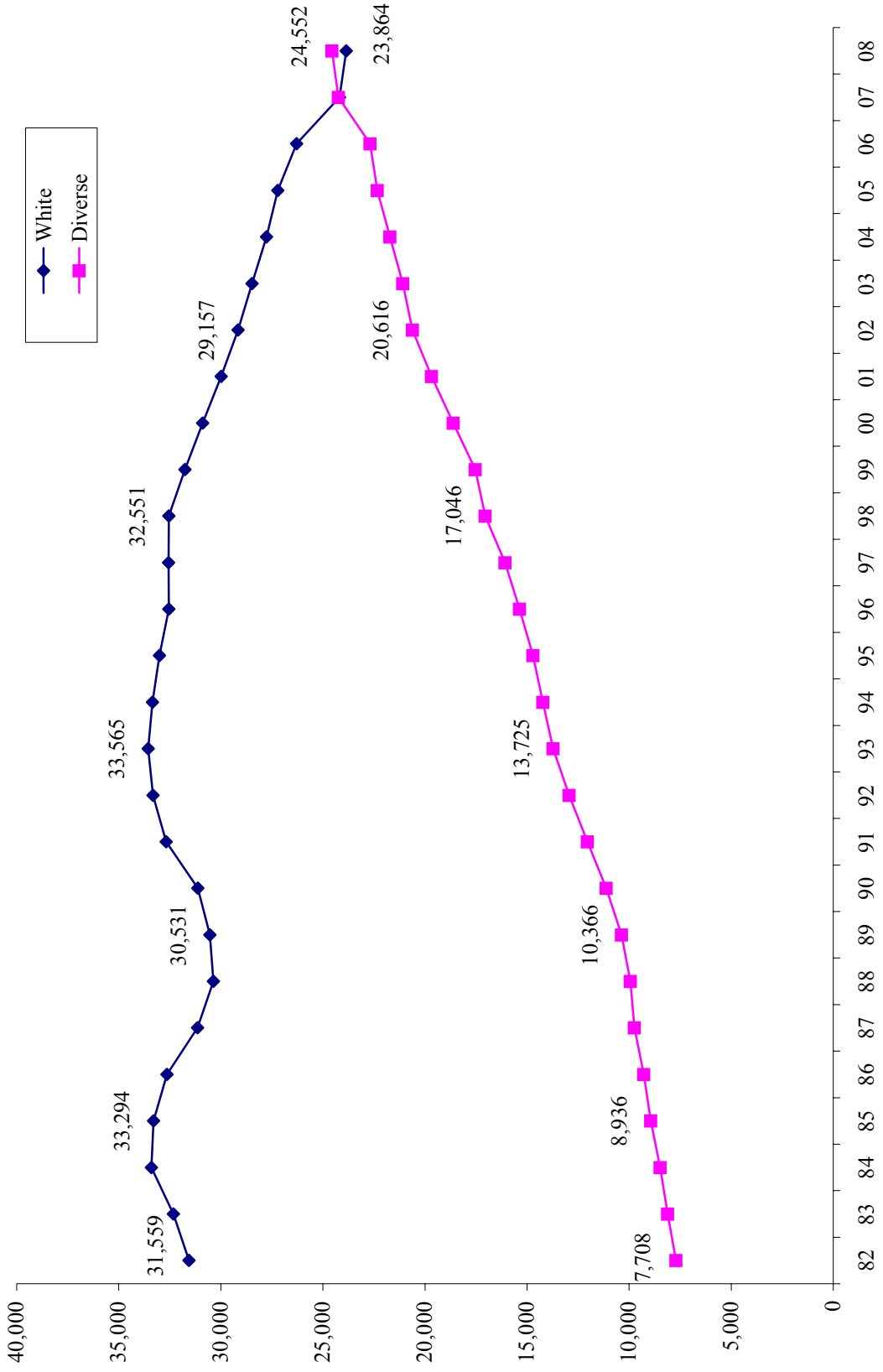
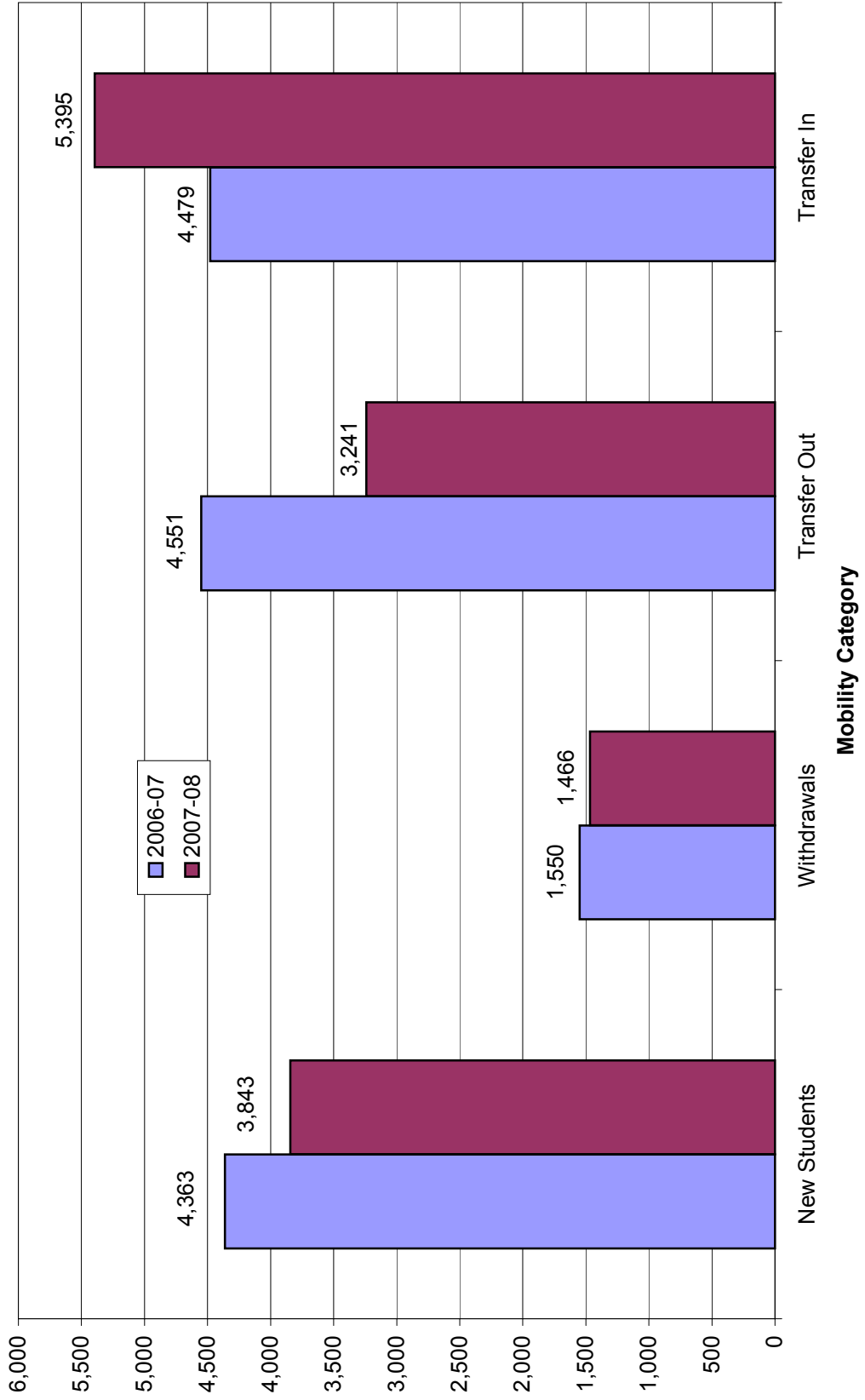
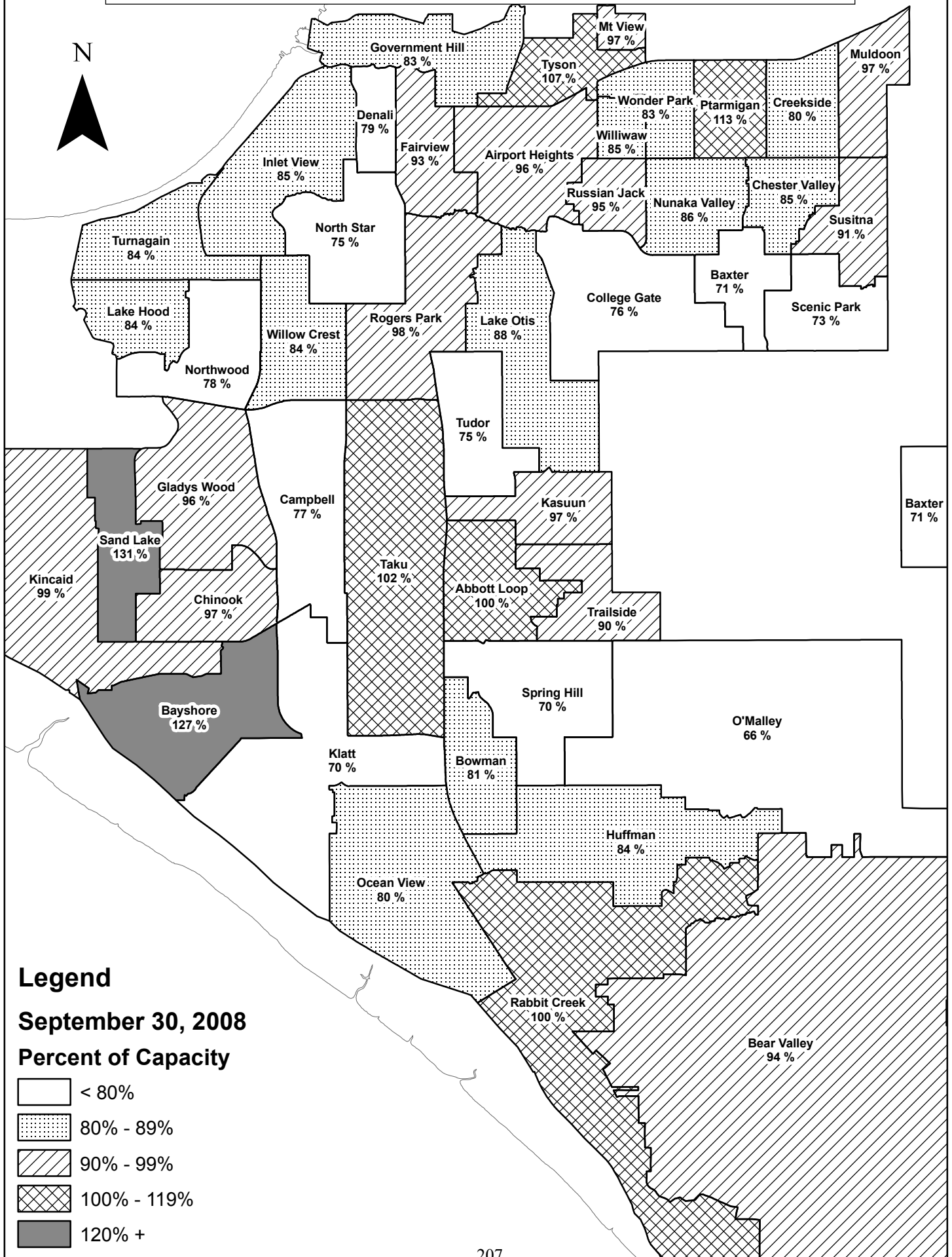

# Percent of Capacity by Elementary Attendance Areas



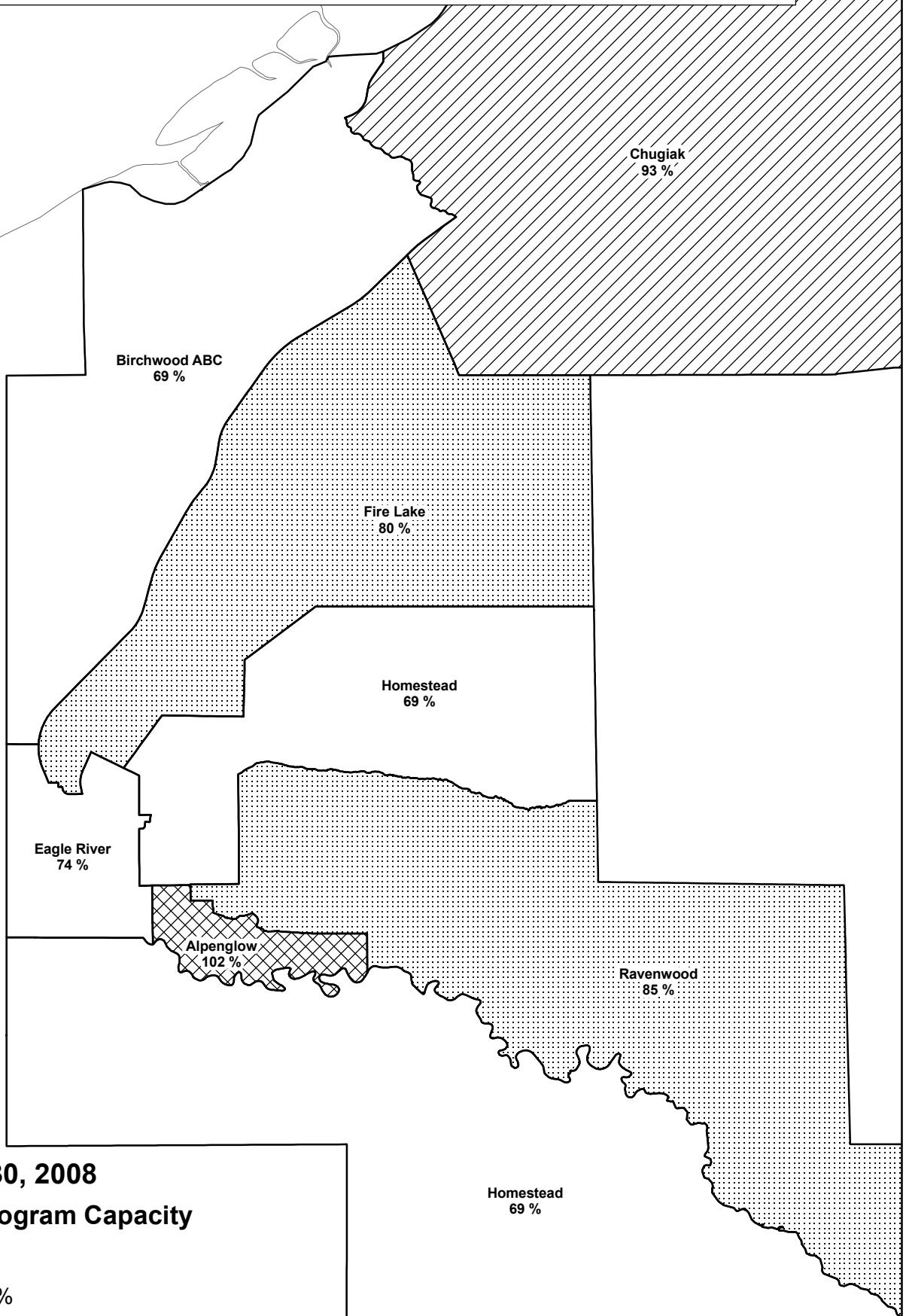




# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak Elementary



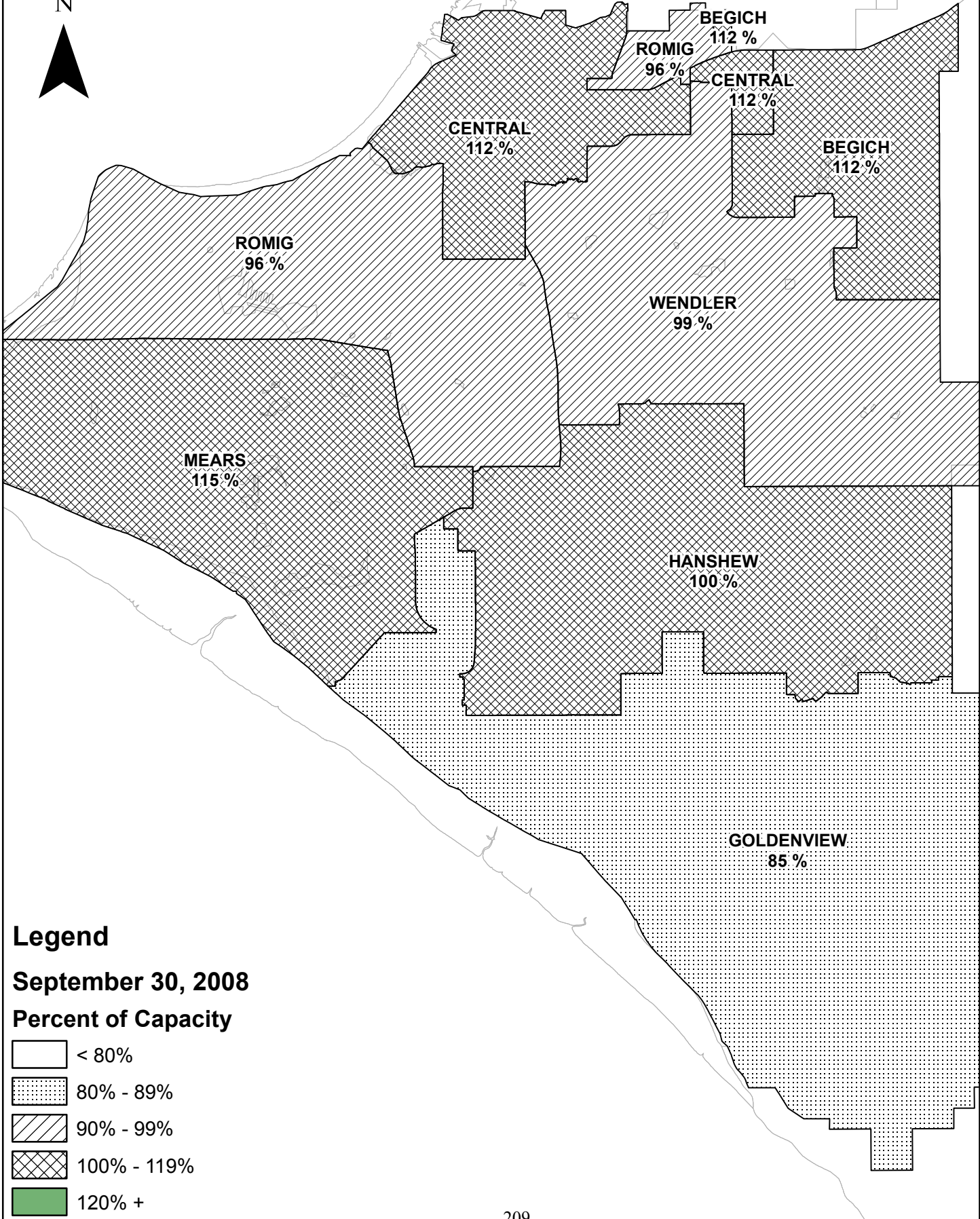






# Percent of Capacity by Middle Attendance Areas

# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak Middle Attendance Areas







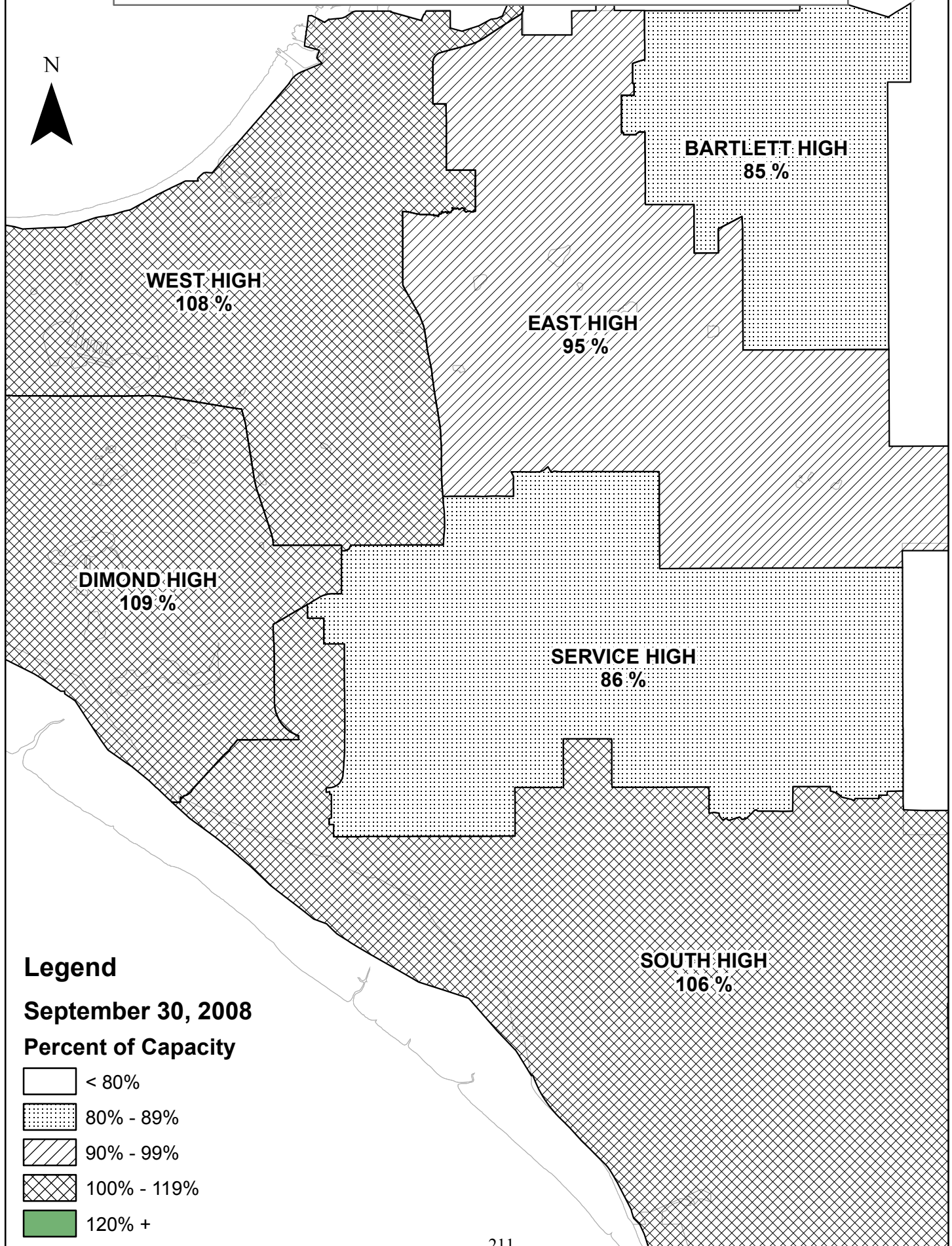





# Percent of Capacity by High School Attendance Areas

# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak High School Attendance Areas





