SUBJECT: END-OF-YEAR MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY, FOR 2010-2011

*ASD Goal: All ASD departments support the mission of the District and will be highly effective, efficient, and responsive to internal and external customers.*

PERTINENT FACTS:

The total active enrollment at the end of the 2010-11 school year was 47,787. This enrollment represents a decrease of 1,304 students when compared to the September 30, 2010 total of 49,091. The membership totals are compared in Table 1. Membership declined by 532 students for the same time period for the 2009-10 school year.

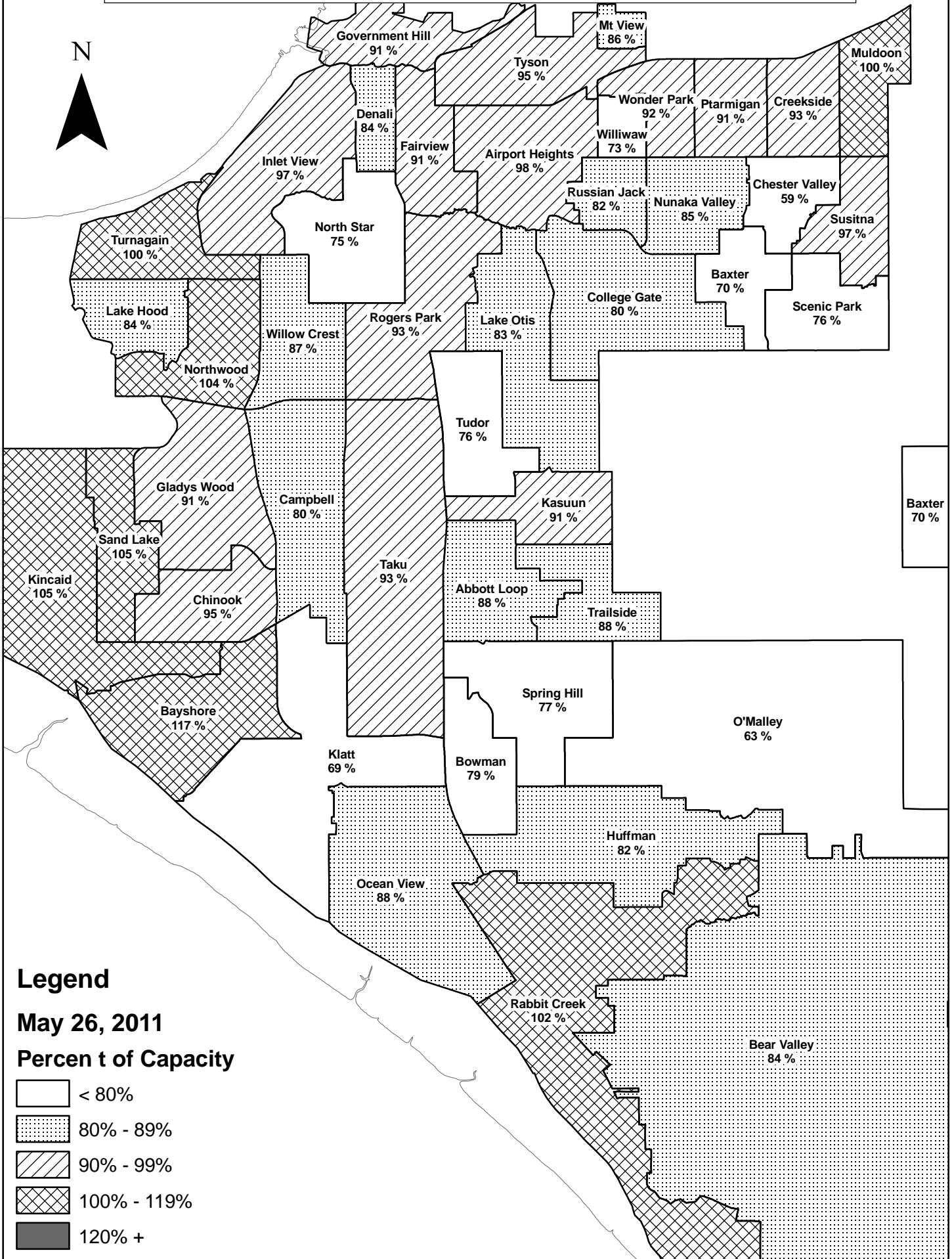

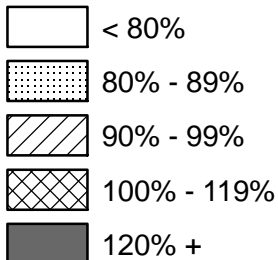
# Percent of Capacity by Elementary Attendance Areas



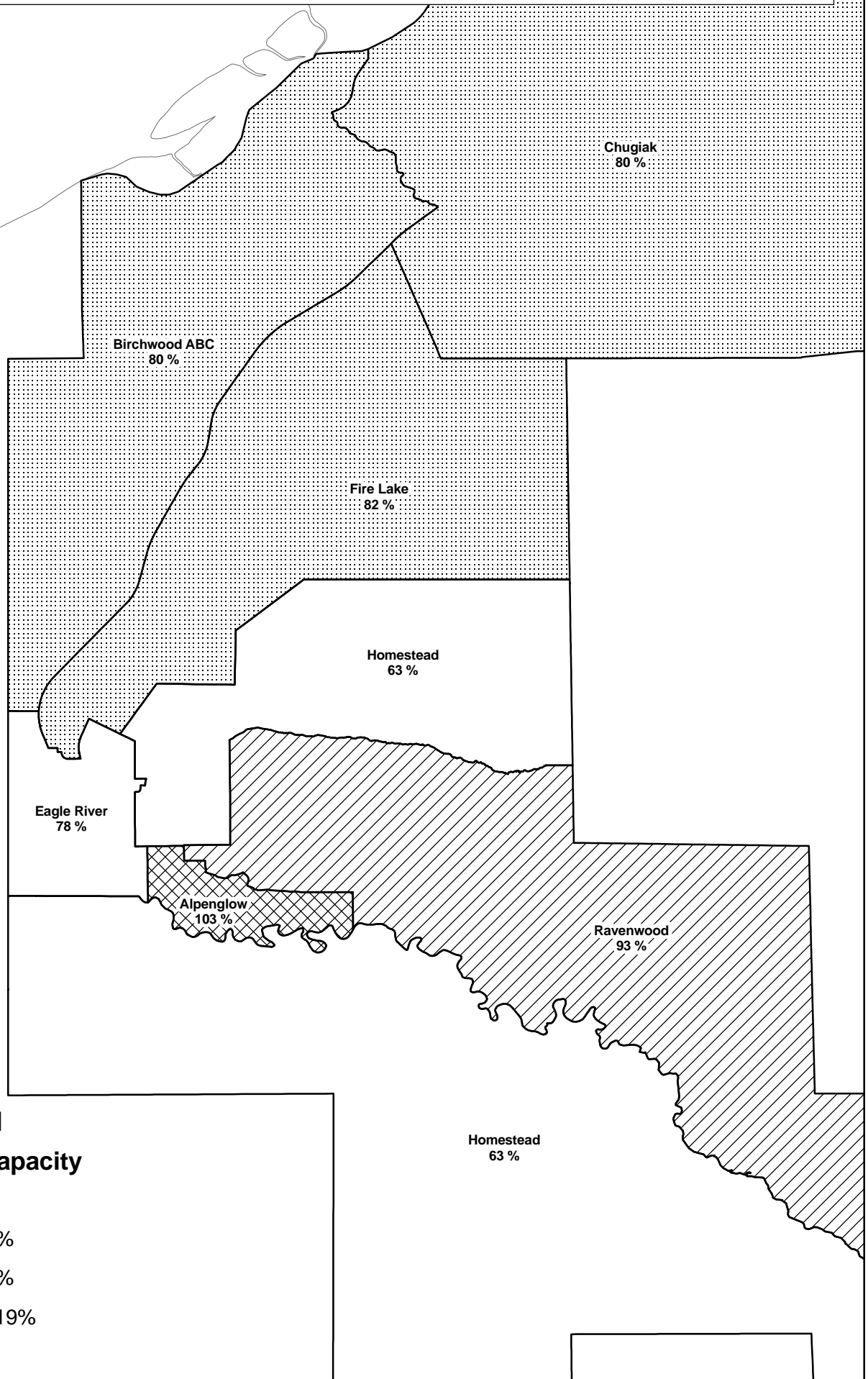






# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak Elementary Attendance Areas



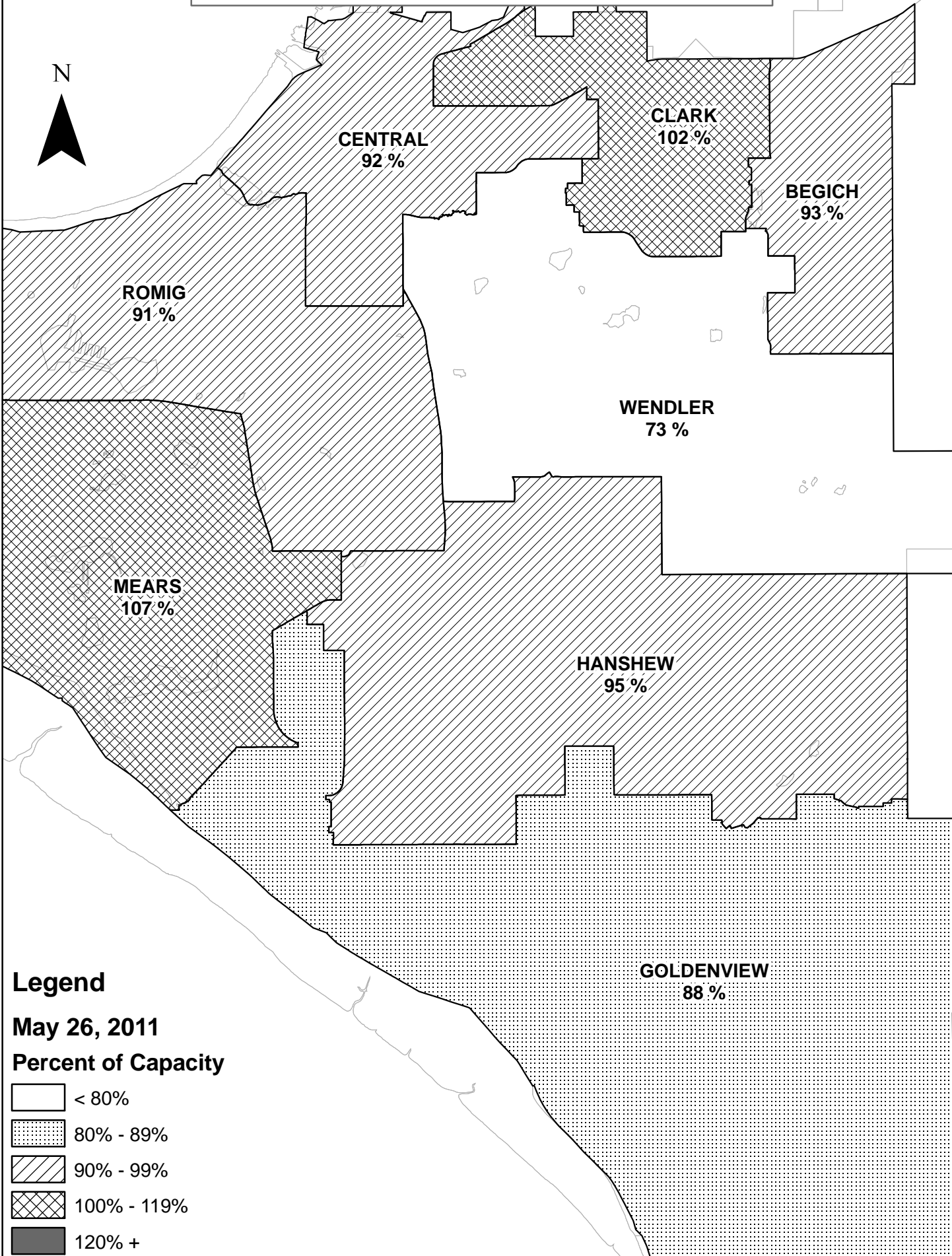



# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak Middle Attendance Areas



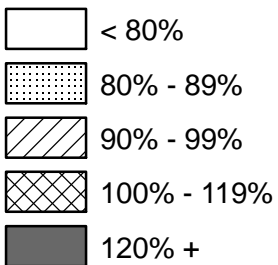

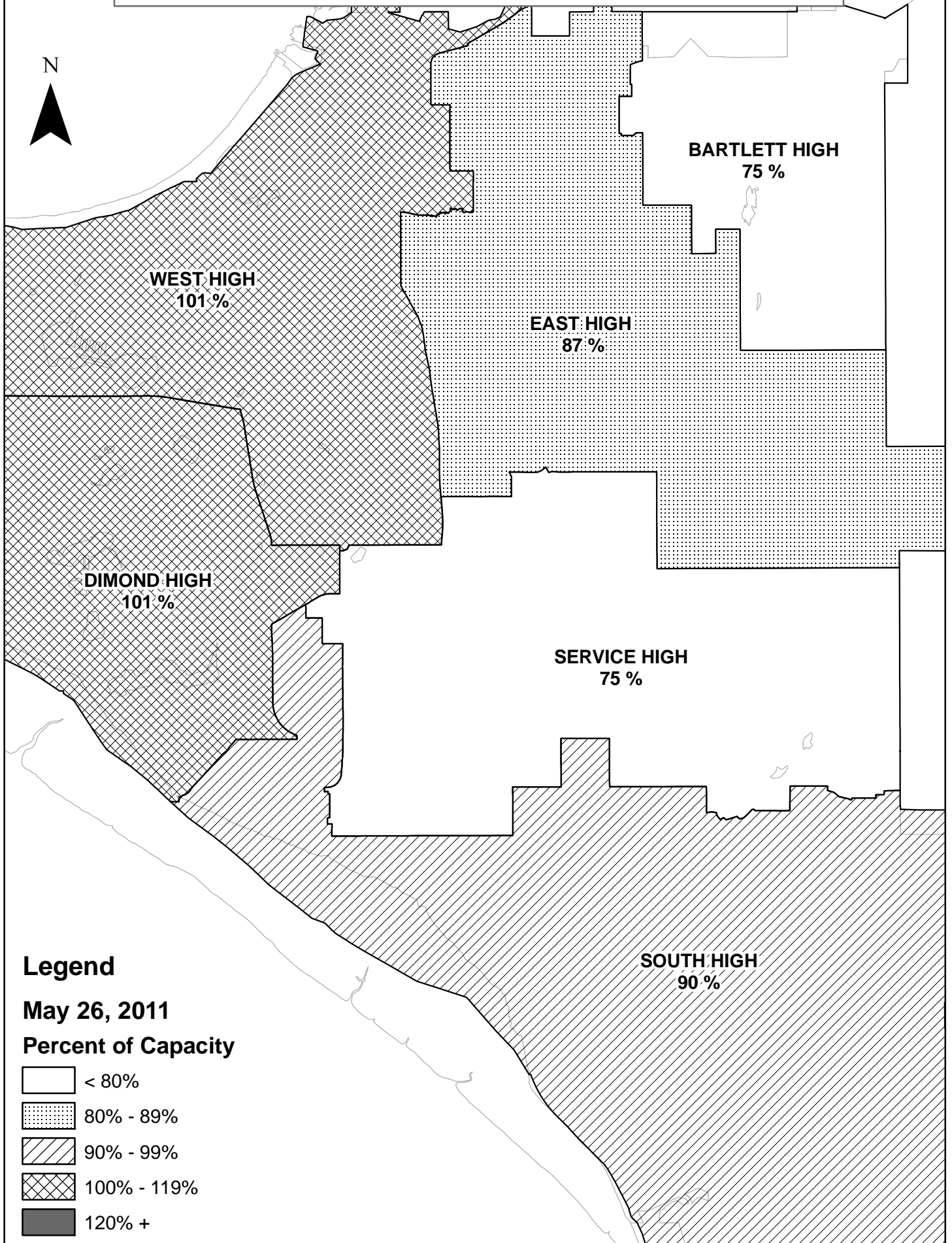

### Percent of Capacity



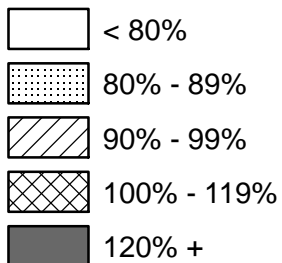
# Percent of Capacity by High School Attendance Areas

# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak High School Attendance Areas







