Configuring TextWrangler for use with Boxnamer

Overview

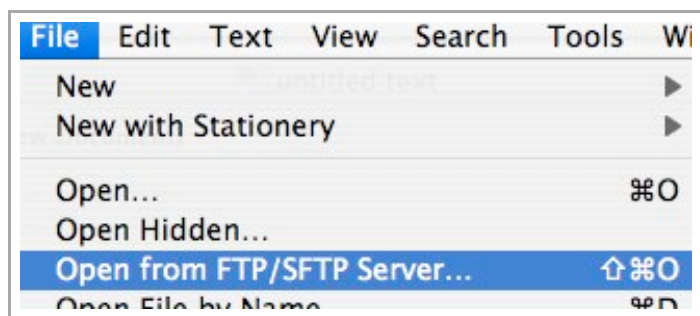
This tutorial describes getting the TextWrangler application setup to edit the name_table.csv file on the fileserver that is used by the boxnamer startup script.

Download TextWrangler

Download TextWrangler. (Check <http://www.barebones.com/products/textwrangler/download.shtml> for versions compatible with MacOS 10.4 and 10.3) When the disk image appears, drag TextWrangler to the desired location. It can be used from a Home folder.

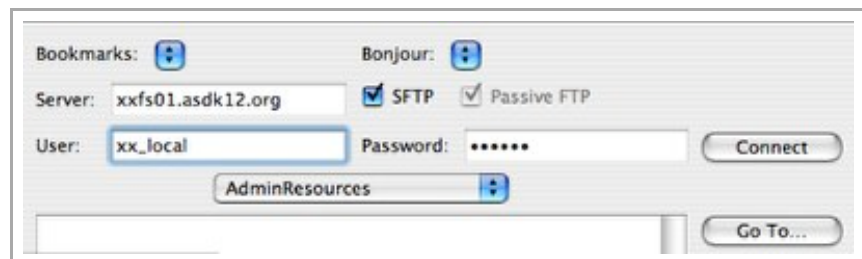
Launch TextWrangler

Once TextWrangler has started use the File menu and select "Open from FTP/SFTP Server..."



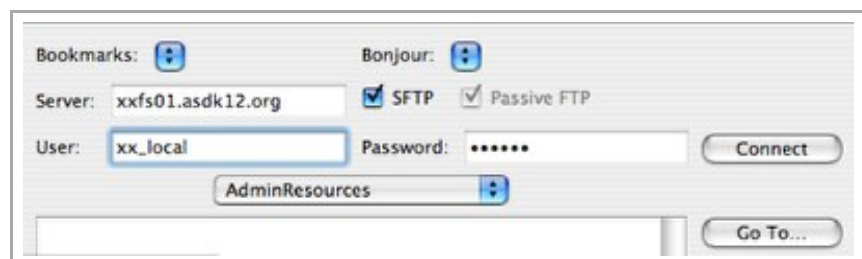
Fill-in the appropriate connection information

When the FTP Browser window appears enter the following information:
Server: xxfs01.asdk12.org
SFTP: check this box
User: xx_local
Password: You should know this



Click the Go To button

It is important to click **Go To** before connecting.



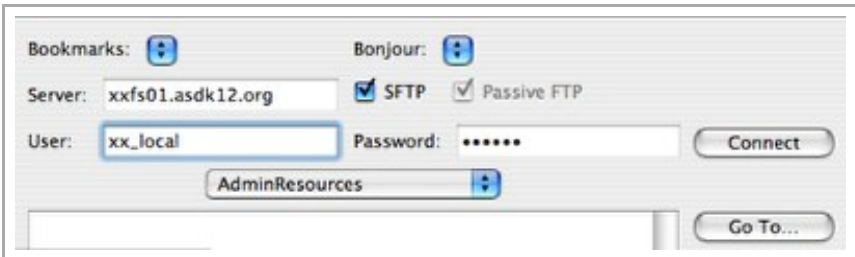
Enter the path to the name_table.csv file as shown in the screenshot

Accuracy counts! Be sure to check spelling and capitalization.



Click Connect

Be sure all the information has been entered, including the **Go To** path.



Double click name_table.csv to begin editing

The name_table.csv file will be open. Any changes to this file will take effect when client computers are restarted.
