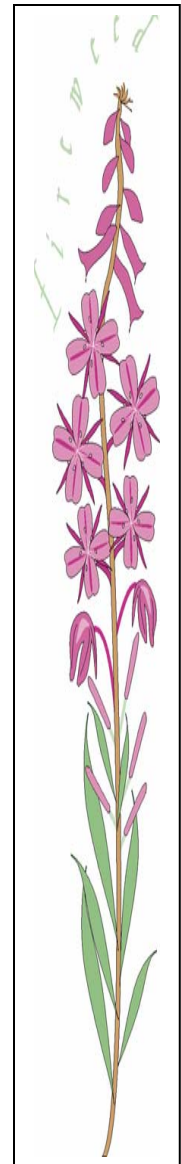

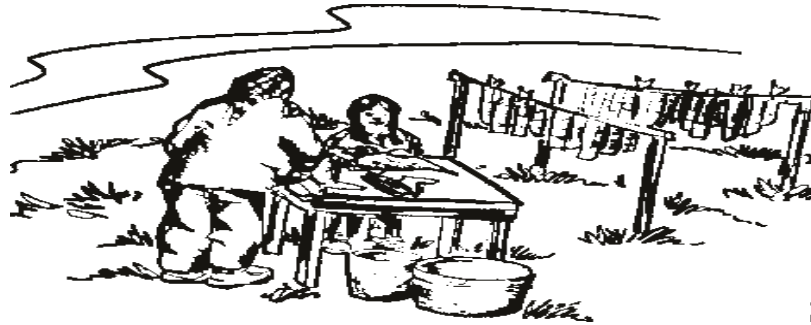

Muldoon Elementary**

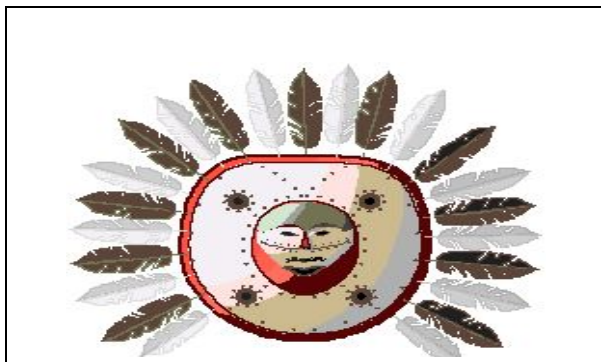
