SALON SERVICES

Course Description: This introductory course is designed to provide the student with an opportunity to become familiar with the cosmetology profession. Emphasis is placed on professional practices and safety. In this class, you will learn practical and professional cosmetology skills including shampooing and styling, skin care and make-up application, application, hair and scalp treatments, nail care, hair coloring and lightening. Students will learn of the latest trends in hair styles and fashions from publications in the fashion and cosmetology industry.

INTRODUCTION TO SHAMPOOING & STYLING

- Demonstrate proper draping of a client, including wet, chemical and dry hair services.
- Identify different type of shampooing procedures, relating to the salon services to be performed.
- Demonstrate proper scalp massage and rinsing of client, for a basic salon service.
- Identify safety procedures while performing shampooing services.
- Identify instruments used in blow drying and thermal techniques.
- Demonstrate the proper use and handling of thermal curling irons.
- Demonstrate proper maintenance and sanitary procedures for styling tools.
- Demonstrate safety procedures for styling services.

INTRODUCTION TO SKIN CARE & MAKE-UP APPLICATION

- Identify normal, dry and oily skin.
- List and identify products and supplies needed to perform plain facial services.
- Demonstrate the basic facial massage movements.
- Identify supplies needed for a professional make-up application.

- Demonstrate how to professionally apply make-up.
- Identify situations where corrective make-up applications may be desired.
- List various products and supplies needed for corrective make-up applications.
- Identify safety procedures for skin care services.

INTRODUCTION TO HAIR AND SCALP TREATMENTS

- Identify different types of hair reconditioning products.
- Demonstrate the application of conditioners.
- Demonstrate scalp treatment, including scalp massages.
- Demonstrate corrective hair and scalp treatments.
- Recognize scalp and hair disorders and know when to refer clients for medical assistance.
- Demonstrate safety procedures in hair and scalp treatments.

INTRODUCTION TO NAIL CARE

- Identify products, supplies and implements needed for a manicure.
- Demonstrate proper techniques for giving a plain manicure.
- Demonstrate the basic hand massage movements.
- Identify safety procedures for nail care services.

INTRODUCTION TO HAIR COLORING

- Identify how the chemical process of coloring changes the hair.
- Demonstrate how to perform a predisposition or patch test.
- Demonstrate how to perform a strand test.
- Explain the importance of keeping clients records for coloring services.
- Demonstrate how to give a color rinse, semi-permanent tint, and permanent tint.
- Demonstrate how to “mix” an aniline derivative tint.
- Demonstrate how to section for a virgin tint or touch-up applications.
- Demonstrate safety procedures for hair coloring services.

INTRODUCTION TO HAIR LIGHTENING

- Demonstrate how to section for a hair lightening service.
- Demonstrate process of giving a one-step virgin tint and a one-step tint retouch.
- Demonstrate introductory techniques and procedures for giving a hair lightening treatment.
- Demonstrate safety procedures for hair coloring and lightening services.
