SUBJECT: SECOND QUARTER END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP  
SUMMARY - JANUARY 30, 2009

ASD Goal: *Ensure public accountability through effective communication with students, staff, parents, community and government at all levels.*

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for January 30, 2009 is attached (Attachment A). The total active enrollment at the end of January was 48,855. This enrollment represents an increase of 415 students when compared to the September 30, 2008 total of 48,440. The membership totals are compared in the following table:

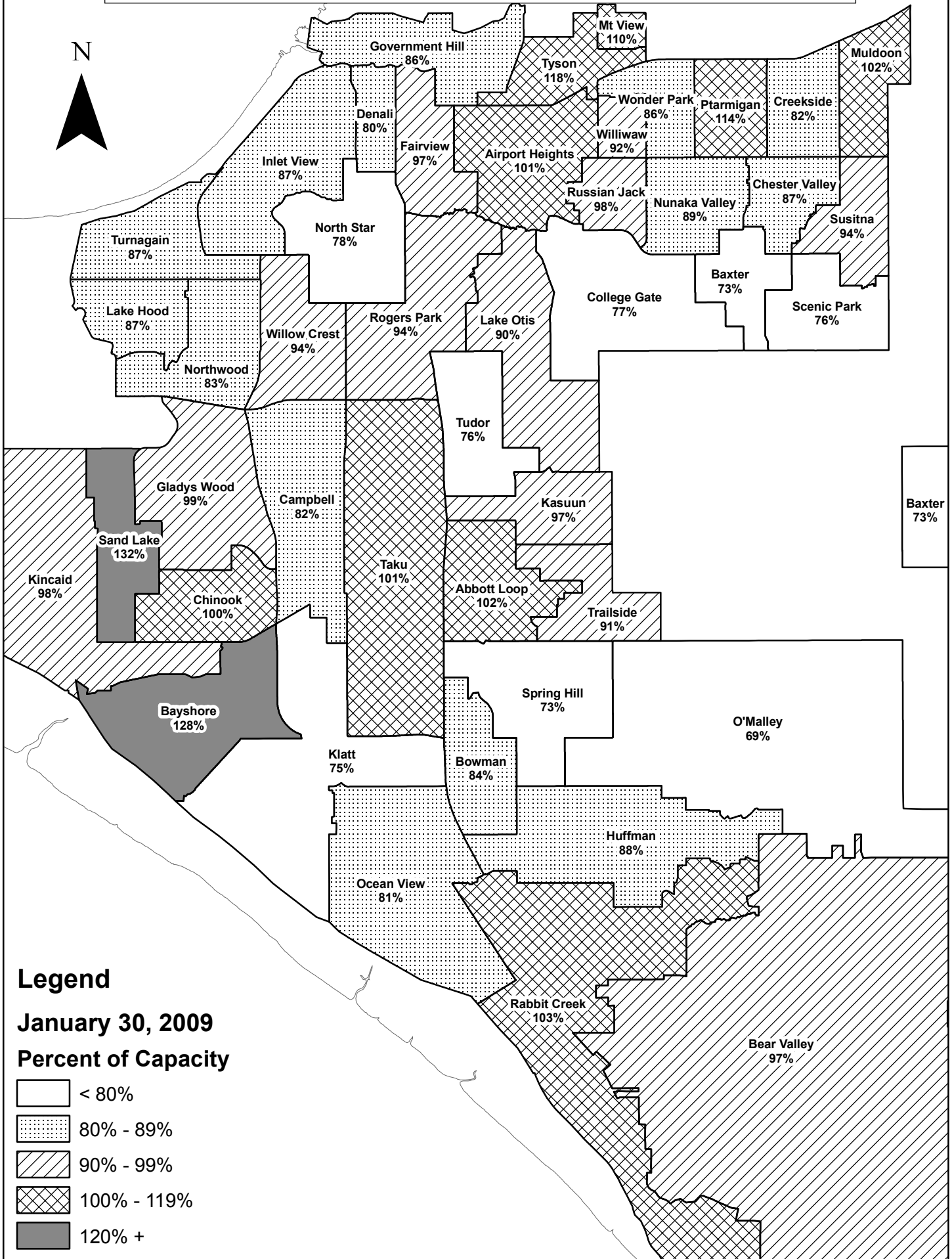

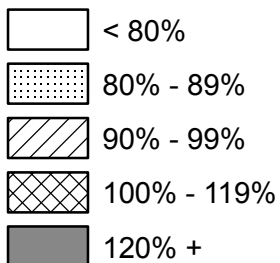

# Percent of Capacity by Elementary Attendance Areas

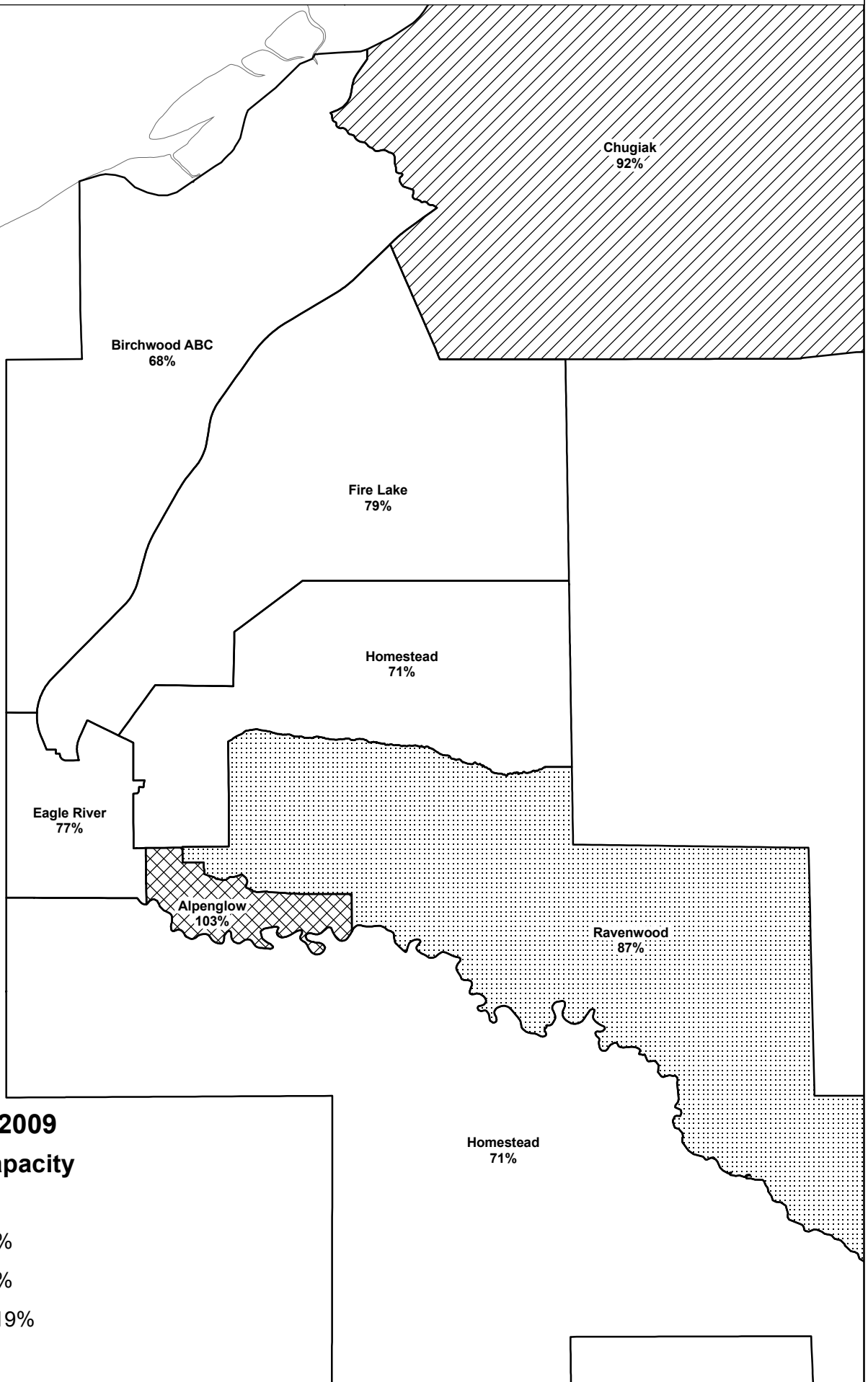






# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak Elementary Attendance Areas

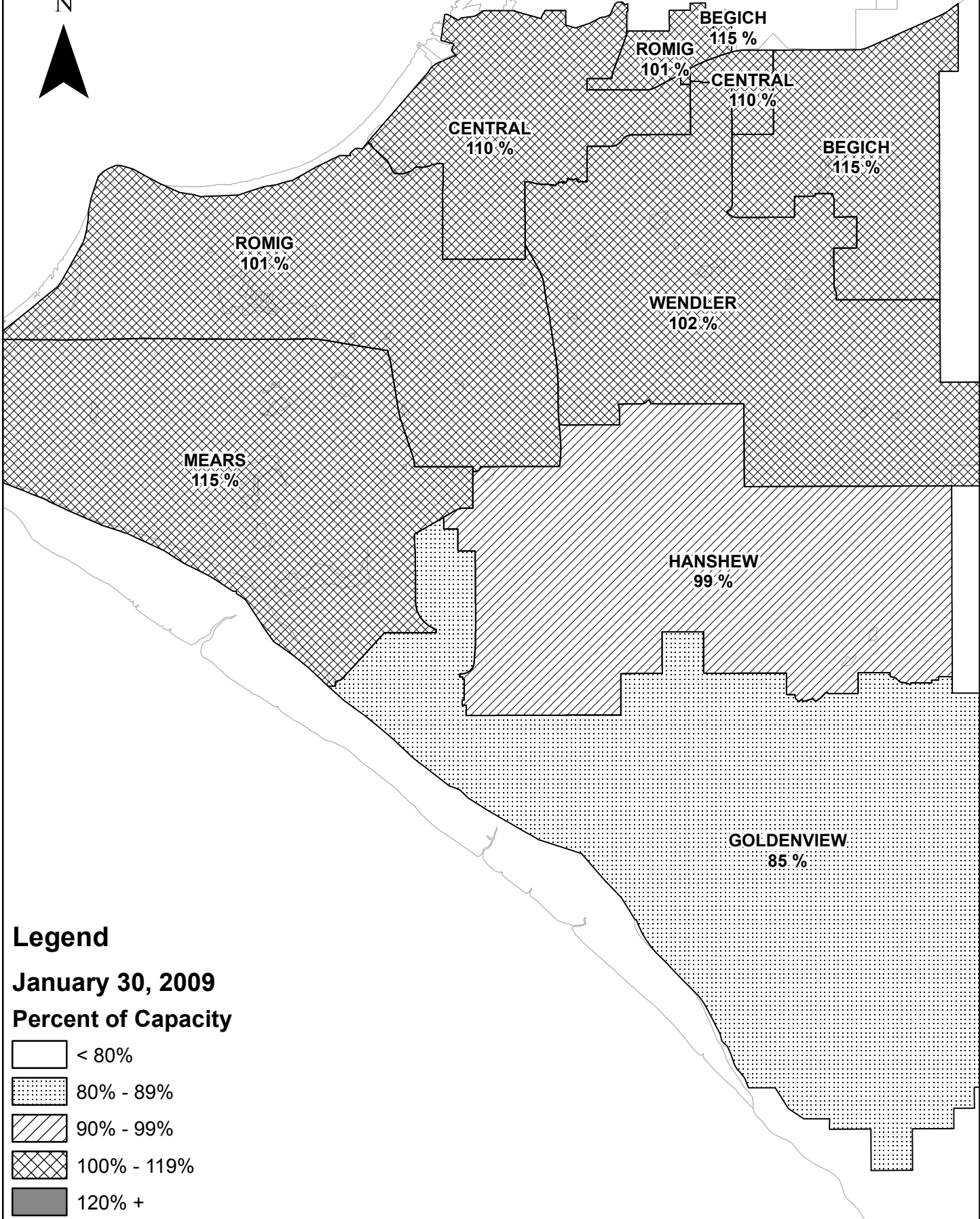





# Percent of Capacity by Middle Attendance Areas

# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak Middle Attendance Areas










# Percent of Capacity by High School Attendance Areas

# Percent of Capacity by Eagle River/Chugiak High School Attendance Areas





