Subject/Theme: Creative Writing/Writer's Workshop	Materials, Application(s), Visuals: Computer lab, <i>Kidspiration</i> application, projector	
Guiding Questions: How would creating a picture of your ideas help you to write a story?	Procedure: Demonstration given on computer connected to projector. Child assist me as I brainstorm information about myself. Include likes, dislikes, character traits, etc. Explanation/demonstration given on how to change to color.
