



Introduction: TLC 2.0 update: Enhancements – Screen shot not ASD data

Full Title displays: Has been an issue in series + title.

1. Cursor is enhanced with yellow and blue
 - Previously users had difficulty in seeing where the cursor was currently focused, especially when using the Check In option in LS2 Circ. Entry boxes with cursor focus will now be outlined with a bluish glow and display a background color of yellow.
2. Add item - the *Call Number* now populates
3. Add item retains all info to add several copies
4. Request displays barcode associated with the title (Actions drop down)
5. Full MARC in LS2 Circ
6. Show past 3 borrowers (option On or Off – off = current view only last borrower)
7. Item details- additional fields
 - Fields, under Circulation Info, are as follows: Total Renewals, Renewals This Period, Total In-House Use, In-House Use This Period, Date Added, and Date Inventoried.
8. ISBN: 10 or 13 digits will display, plus a link will show additional ISBN's (current screen shot does not show more than 1 ISBN)

Borrower extra information – Lost pop-up

Excused Losses and Items Lost counts displayed differently in LS2 Circ and LS4.2 Circulation for the same borrower account, as the items marked Lost by the automated Long Overdue to Lost process were not included in the count in LS2 Circ. This has been corrected.

Additionally, a **new column, Date Lost**, has been added to the Items Lost and Excused Losses pop-ups which displays after clicking the associated links under the Borrower Maintenance Info area of the Extra Info tab in Borrower Info. Refer to the example below which shows the Items Lost pop-up after clicking the Items Lost link in the Borrower Maintenance Info area.
