A school band, choir, or orchestra concert is a much more formal event than a popular music concert or a hockey game.

Once the music is about to begin, please remain in your seat and refrain from talking with your neighbors until the concert is over. If you have young children with you, have them sit quietly.

Please turn off cell phones and pagers, avoid flash photography, and don't wave to the performers.

Please do not leave as soon as your child's portion of the concert is over. This is very discouraging to those students who are last on the program.

Show appreciation by clapping at the end of each piece. Whistling or calling out names is not appropriate.

Most importantly, enjoy the concert and congratulate the performers afterwards. They have worked very hard and deserve much praise and encouragement.
