- To enhance safety in and around schools in the Anchorage School District through the development and implementation of safety measures and programs.
- To enhance the learning environment for students within the Anchorage School District through anti-bullying programs and other measures.
- To provide a high level of police service to the Anchorage School District and neighborhoods surrounding schools.
- To reduce juvenile crime in the community.
- To increase school attendance through an aggressive truancy program.
- To build trust and a positive relationship with students as well as provide students counseling and advice on potential problems involving police.
