SUBJECT: CLARK MIDDLE SCHOOL'S GOOD SAMARITANS

PERTINENT FACTS:

On Friday, May 30, 2003, four Clark Middle School students came to the aid of a fellow student who had fallen and injured his leg while walking to school.

Clark Middle School students Va Vang, Seng Vang, Kongmoon Yang and Neng Yang, acted quickly and responsibly to aid the injured student, Keng Xiong. They placed him in a tarp to keep him warm and dry and assured him help was on the way.

Two of the students notified the school office and, as a result of their quick thinking, school officials responded to the scene, assessed Mr. Xiong's injury and called 911. When the rescue team arrived on the scene they found Mr. Xiong dry, warm and relaxed.

The actions of these four young men show their concern for the well being of their fellow student and ability to act responsibly during a crisis.

It is requested the School Board recognize Va Vang, Neng Yang, Kongmoon Yang, and Seng Vang for their involvement in this situation.
