Curriculum Corner:

Reading: We read two stories from our reading anthology this week. The first was an English fairy tale called Rustytoes and the other was a story about a boy who has the goal of reaching the top of a high mesa in New Mexico. The story is Katzimo, Mysterious Mesa.

Writing Process/English: Our current chapter covers capitals and punctuation.

Math: We began working with division in decimals this week. We worked on dividing by 10, 100, and 1000 . The students took a midyear cumulative review test.

Social Studies: We had some map work as well as newspaper search discussion on subsistence.

Science: The students tested the two nichrome wires in the circuits unit to see if length and thickness of the wires affected the brightness of their bulbs. We also created a test circuit to demonstrate what a fuse was.

Health: Students are learning to be wise consumers. We are using the labels brought in for homework to compare products.
