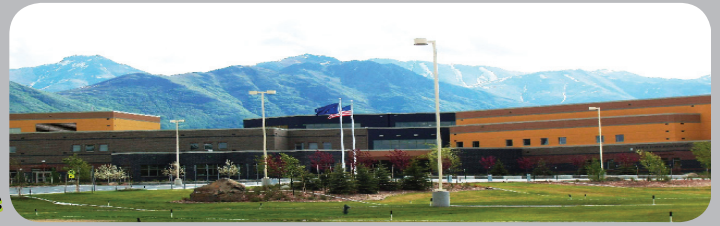

## *Nurse Notes*

Welcome back! I'm looking forward to another great year at Eagle River High School.

### **IMMUNIZATIONS**

Please provide the school nurse with a copy of your child's shot record each time they receive an immunization in order to update their school health records. A **Tetanus Booster** is required usually at age 15 (ten years from their last DTP).

### **MEDICATIONS**

All student medications must be provided in the original container from the pharmacy and parental written consent for administration at school. All medications, with the exception of inhalers for asthma and epipens for allergies (with doctor permission), must be kept in the nurse's office and administered by the nurse. Parents must complete the necessary ASD medication form and provide the medication for their child.

### **TUBERCULOSIS (TB) SCREENING**

Alaska state law requires TB screening for students enrolled in public schools. All kindergarten, seventh grade and new-to-district students will be screened. A consent form must be signed by parent or guardian at the time of registration. Documentation for a TB test from a health care provider will be accepted if it is within six months.

### **ILLNESS**

A student who appears sick should remain at home, especially if a temperature is  $>100^{\circ}$  F. If a student should become ill while at school, they should go to the nurse's office and we will contact parents.

### **PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE) EXCUSES**

All PE excuses must be cleared through the nurse. If a student will need to be out of PE for more than 3 days, a written request from a doctor is necessary. The excuse must specify the length of the absence, return date, and reason excused from PE.

## ***Registration/Schedule Pick Up Fall 2009***

### **NEW TO THE DISTRICT REGISTRATION AND IN-DISTRICT TRANSFERS:**

According to Alaska State Law, all students must present a CURRENT RECORD OF IMMUNIZATION. Students will be allowed to select but will not be allowed to attend classes until an up-to-date immunization record is on file in the school. Both new and returning students must meet immunization requirements for Hepatitis A and B.

Counselors will meet with new-to-district students and ASD Transfer students on August 3, 2009 by appointment only. Please call 742-2740 after July 13, 2009 to schedule an appointment for your student. Immunization records are required for registration.

To register a new student at Eagle River High School, please bring:

1. A current record of immunization.
2. Proof the student lives in the ERHS boundary zone. The following documents must show the name and address of the parent/guardian registering student.
  - a. For military members a copy of your Orders/TLF receipt if staying in temporary housing. For those living in base housing; your housing letter confirming your assigned quarters.
  - b. Non-military members may provide a rental contract/purchase agreement, or a utility bill (such as MEA, MTA, Enstar, AWWU) as proof of physical address.
3. Social security number.
4. Transcript or report card.

### **PREREGISTERED/RETURNING STUDENTS:**

Schedule pick-up and registration procedure for Fall 2009 has been established using two sessions for each grade level (9-12). The groups for each session are divided alphabetically by last name. SCHEDULES NOT PICKED UP ON THE ASSIGNED DAY WILL BE DROPPED FROM THE COMPUTER AT THE END OF THE DAY AND STUDENTS WILL HAVE TO RESCHEDULE WITH COUNSELORS.

## Release and Disclosure of Directory Information

### *School Board Policy 343.34*

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a federal law, requires the District, with certain exceptions, to obtain your consent prior to disclosing personal information from your student's education records. The law recognizes, though, that schools often desire to publish student information, for example, to recognize students through awards or athletic programs. Additionally, outside organizations such as colleges, legislators, the military, and vendors for items such as photographs or class rings, often seek contact information for students. To meet this need, FERPA allows the District to designate as "directory information" any personally identifiable information in a student's educational records that would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if disclosed. School officials may release directory information about a student without first obtaining parental consent, unless you object by returning this form.

The District has identified the following information as directory information: student name, address, e-mail, year of birth, enrollment, dates of attendance, grade level, degrees and awards received, date of graduation, name of secondary school most recently attended, scholarship eligibility, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, and height and weight of members of interscholastic athletic teams. This list is found at Anchorage School Board Policy 343.34. A copy of this policy is available for review in the office of all of our schools or on the District's website.

In two instances, the District is required by law to release certain contact information regarding junior and senior high school students, unless you object. First, the District is required to provide to the University of Alaska the names and addresses of those students eligible for UA scholarship programs. Second, upon receiving a request from military recruiters and/or institutions of higher learning, the District must provide names, addresses, and telephone listings. The form below specifically allows you, as a parent, to object to release of phone numbers and directory information to military recruiters and colleges.

If you do not want the District to disclose directory information from your student's education records during the 2009-2010 school year, you must notify the District, in writing, by returning this form. **If you have no objections to the release of directory information, you do not need to take any action.**

As a parent or a student 18 or over, you have the right to request that student directory information is not released to military recruiters and others. **Complete this release and disclosure of directory information form and give it to your Principal or School Administrator.**

If you would like to limit the release of directory information, please check below all the situations in which you would like to deny release of directory information:

Selection of this option will also prohibit release of information to **military recruiters** and **post-secondary schools and universities** and **will also deny publication of the student's name in the graduation program and in the list of graduating seniors in the local paper.**

\_\_\_ Deny all Directory Information Releases **EXCEPT** local publication of the student's name in graduation programs and listings. Checking this option **ALLOWS** this limited publication.

\_\_\_ Deny only release to **Armed Forces and Military Recruiters, or Military Schools**. Checking this option allows all other releases.

\_\_\_ Deny only release to **Post-secondary education institutions**. Checking this option allows all other releases.

**This form, requesting that the student's private information not be released, must be renewed annually.**

Federal public law 107-110, section 9528 of the ESEA, "No Child Left Behind Act" requires school districts to release student names, addresses, and phone numbers to military recruiters upon their request. Students may then be called at home by recruiters about joining the military. The law also requires the school district to notify you of your right to Opt-Out from this by requesting that the district not release your information to military recruiters. The completion and return of this form serves as your request to withhold directory information.

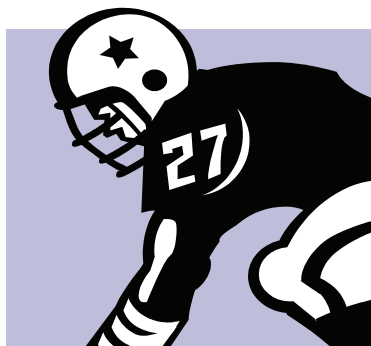

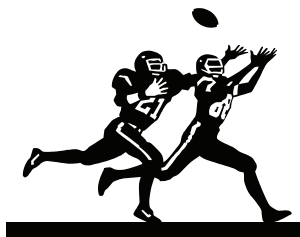

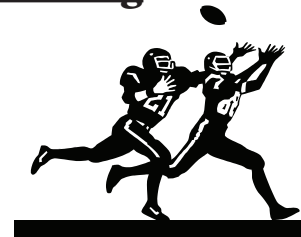
