- 1) 2011-12 High School Athletic/Activity Participation Form signed by student & parent/guardian
- 2) ASD Health Examination Form signed by doctor, student & parent/guardian
- 3) TAD/Play for Keeps Acknowledgement Form signed by student & parent/ guardian (Watch video at ASAA.org)
- 4) Concussion Fact Sheet/Parent Acknowledgement for sports activities only (signed by student & parent/guardian)
- 5) ImPACT Baseline Screening
- 6) Cash or check payable to ERHS

**Activity fees are: \$5 concussion baseline fee is required for all sports (no waiver) plus \$175 per activity** - tennis, cross country running, cheerleading, track and field, drama debate/forensics  
**\$185 per activity** - flag football, volleyball, cross country skiing, football, wrestling, basketball, riflery, soccer

**\$195 per activity** - gymnastics, swimming and diving, hockey

**The activity fees are required unless:**

A student applies for and receives a fee waiver based on hardship through the school activity office or a family meets the \$390 cap\* for middle or high school activity fees.

**Please note:** Baseball, softball and bowling are not sponsored by ASD so separate fees must be paid to the individual sponsor. These fees do not count toward ASD's family cap.

- Athletes must be enrolled in at least 5 ASD classes to participate in sports
- 4th qtr/2<sup>nd</sup> sem. grades will be verified for: 2.0 GPA minimum & 5 classes passed; (this rule does not apply to incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders until the end of 1<sup>st</sup> qtr.)
- Seniors who are on track to graduate (have passed all HSGQE exams and have at least 18.5 credits ) may enroll in 4 classes and still be eligible.

You must complete the eligibility process with the Activities Office **before you are allowed to begin practice with any team.**
