NEBULA students value their education; they understand that academic performance leads to extracurricular enjoyment.

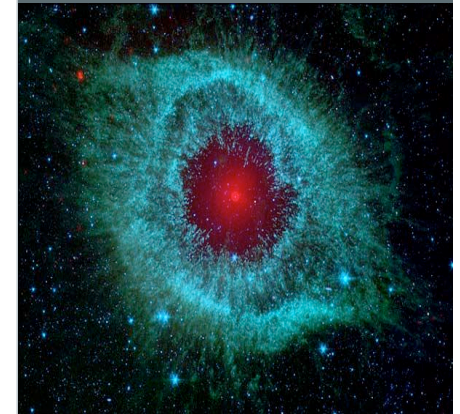

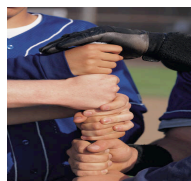
