

Parking

Vehicle Registration Policy: Driving and parking a vehicle on Service High School campus is an earned privilege, not a right. All students parking on campus must have a valid parking permit. A parking permit application can be obtained in the Student Services Office in Lower D. Fines and/or discipline can be issued to students who are in violation of the parking permit contract; for unregistered vehicles in the parking lot; parking violations; safety violations; etc. Visitors to campus must obtain a visitor parking permit from the Student Services office in Lower D. **Lost or stolen permits will not be replaced.** Continual violations will result in **revocation** of driving privileges on school property. *In the event that some offenses are not specifically addressed in this document, the decorum issues discussed herein should serve as guidelines to determine the appropriate sanctions.*

The school principal or designee may search automobiles that are parked on school grounds if he or she wishes to establish whether drugs, alcohol, weapons, dangerous or illegal materials, or stolen goods may be located within the vehicle. All students utilizing the privilege of parking on school grounds have consented to such a search under the terms and conditions of their Parking Permits. All vehicles parked on school grounds by a student, whether or not a permit has been obtained, may be searched when there is reasonable cause to believe that the items described immediately above may be located within the vehicle.
