



2009-2010 Robert Service High School Dance Policy

All Service High School students are welcome to attend school sponsored dances. Attendance is a privilege, not a right. In order to create a safe and healthy environment, the Service High School Student Government has developed a dance policy that students must sign in order to be eligible to attend.

- All those attending dances **must** follow the Anchorage School District dress code, as detailed in the Student Handbook.
“Students are not allowed to wear clothing (t-shirts, hats, etc.) that display obscenity, profanity, sexual innuendoes; or pictures that promote or glamorize drugs, tobacco and alcohol, or disrupts student learning an/or the educational process. This also includes any garments with pictures of drugs, tobacco, alcohol or any related paraphernalia. Clothing that allows for indecent exposure is also prohibited. For example: clothing that displays the abdomen/navel, midriff, chest, or that allows underwear to show, etc. Headwear is not permitted indoors”.
- Security and chaperones will be present and behavior that violates ASD policy, such as **inappropriate dancing**, will result in removal from the dance and a ban from one subsequent dance. Inappropriate behavior includes, but is not limited to: **Moshing, Grinding, Freak Dancing, Slamming, or the use of drugs or alcohol.**
- Anyone attending the dance must arrive before half of the dance is over (in most cases that is 9:30PM)
- Be aware that all vehicles are subject to search for any illegal items. Possession of illegal substances or items will result in police action.

Wristbands (Home dances only)

Upon entry to a dance, after presenting proper ID, you will receive a wristband. If you are involved in any inappropriate behavior during the dance, your wristband will be removed by an Administrator or Security, you will be asked to leave, and will not be allowed to attend the next dance. Same behavior policy applies to proms.
