

The 5 Most Important Things to Know about Alaska are...

You may work alone or with another person. Review the materials and notes you have from the course. From this review, identify the 5 most important things people should know about Alaska. State each item and list them on a poster in reverse priority order. Number 5 should be the one on your list that is the least important of the 5 items. The items should progress in priority order so that listed last is #1, the most important item on the list.

Additionally, on a separate paper write the same list in the same order adding a short paragraph for each item that explains and justifies its significance and placement on the list. The items you select should not be superficial facts such as "Mount McKinley is the highest mountain in North America," but should reflect the deeper themes and issues which we have studied e.g. "Elizabeth Peratrovitch and the Anti-Discrimination Act of 1945."

On the poster that lists your items, draw or paste pretty pictures that illustrate Alaska and the items you've chosen.
