

Battle of the Books will meet Tuesdays and Thursdays during lunch beginning the week of October 3<sup>rd</sup>. The school Battle is tentatively scheduled for Friday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012, with 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders competing against each other. The one winning team from the school will compete in the District Battle, tentatively scheduled for Thursday, February 9<sup>th</sup>. If our team wins the District Battle, the State Battle is usually the last week of February.

You do not need to have a team already formed to join Battle of the Books! If you do already have a team you want to work with, please indicate below. Student-chosen teams will be honored as much as possible, but it may become necessary to add or move a team member in some instances. If you do not have teammates, I will place you on an appropriate team by January.

Students must be well behaved and considerate during practices and competition. Disruptive behavior could result in removal from Battle of the Books. During all three of the competitions the judge's decisions are final and students and parents must abide by those decisions.
