***Eragon* by Christopher Paolini PAO**

In Aagaesia, a fifteen-year-old boy of unknown lineage called Eragon finds a mysterious stone that weaves his life into an intricate tapestry of destiny, magic, and power, peopled with dragons, elves, and monsters. Book one

***The Fire Within* by Chris D'Lacey DLA**

When college student David Rain rents a room in an unusual boardinghouse full of clay dragons, he has no idea that they, along with some lively squirrels, will help jumpstart his writing career. Book one

A collection of both new and previously published stories and poems about dragons.

***Jeremy Thatcher, Dragon Hatcher* by

Sixth-grader Jeremy Thatcher discovers a strange magic shop he has never seen before. He enters, and his life is changed forever. Buying what he thinks is a marble, he discovers he has really purchased a dragon's egg.

***Joust* by Mercedes Lackey LAC**

Vetch, an Altan serf, must learn the secret of the Tian jousts and their dragons in order to save his people. Book one.

***The Last Dragon* by Silvana De Mari DEM**

Struggling to survive in a post apocalyptic world after his village is destroyed, Yorsh, the earth's last elf, must embark on a perilous quest to decipher a powerful prophecy and find the last dragon, which holds the key to saving the world from the Dark Age that has begun.

***Roverandom* by JRR Tolkien TOL**

A dog that has been turned into a toy dog encounters rival wizards and experiences various adventures on the moon with giant spiders, dragon moths, and the Great White Dragon.

***The Runaway Princess* by Kate Coombs
COO**

Fifteen-year-old Princess Meg uses magic and her wits to rescue a baby dragon and escape the unwanted attentions of princes hoping to gain her hand in marriage through a contest arranged by her father, the king.

***St. George and the Dragon: a Golden
Legend* by Margaret Hodges 398.2 H**

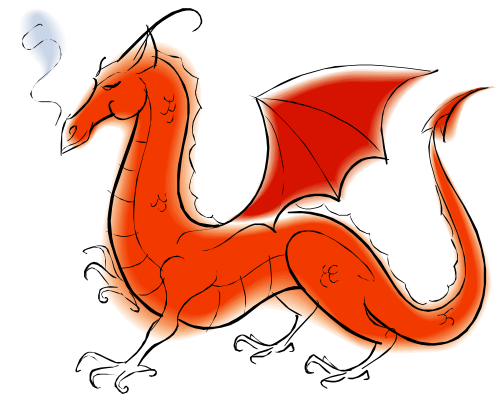

***Beowulf* by James Rumsford 829.3 R**

An illustrated retelling of the exploits of the Anglo-Saxon warrior, Beowulf, and how he came to defeat the monster Grendel, Grendel's mother, and a dragon that threatened the kingdom.

***The Book of Dragons* by Michael Hague 398.2 B**

A collection of short stories featuring dragons, by such authors as Italo Calvino, Kenneth Grahame, and Elizabeth Coatsworth.



***Dealing with Dragons* by Patricia Wrede WRE**

Bored with traditional palace life, a princess goes off to live with a group of dragons and soon becomes involved with fighting against some disreputable wizards who want to steal away the dragons' kingdom. Book one

***The Discovery of Dragons* by Graeme Base 398.2 B**

A collection of "rare historical documents" (chiefly letters and dispatches) written by three intrepid adventurers (a Viking explorer, a Chinese female travelling merchant, and a Prussian explorer/cartographer), describing the famous dragons they discovered.

***Dragon Rider* by Cornelia Funke FUN**

After learning that humans are headed toward his hidden home, Firedrake, a silver dragon, is joined by a brownie and an orphan boy in a quest to find the legendary valley known as the Rim of Heaven, encountering friendly and unfriendly creatures along the way, and struggling to evade the relentless pursuit of an old enemy.

***Dragon Slippers* by Jessica Day George GEO**

Orphaned after a fever epidemic, Creel befriends a dragon and unknowingly inherits an object that can either save or destroy her kingdom. Book one

***Dragonhaven* by Robin McKinley MCK**

When Jake Mendoza, who lives in the Smokehill National Park where his father runs the Makepeace Institute of Integrated Dragon Studies, goes on his first solo overnight in the park, he finds an infant dragon whose mother has been killed by a poacher.

***Dragonquest* by Donita Paul PAU**

A dragonkeeper of Paladin, Kale is summoned from the Hall to The Bogs by the Wizard Fenworth to serve as his apprentice and tend his newly hatched meech dragon, Regidor.

***Dragon's Bait* by Vivian Vande Velde VAN**

Wrongly condemned of witchcraft, fifteen-year-old Alys is tempted to take revenge on her accusers when the dragon to which she has been sacrificed turns out to be an ally.

***Dragon's Blood* by Jane Yolen YOL**

Jakkin, a bond boy who works as a Keeper in a dragon nursery on the planet Austar IV, secretly trains a fighting pit dragon of his own in hopes of winning his freedom.

***The Dragon's Eye* by Dugald Steer STE**

In 1882, Daniel and his older sister are unaware that their mother and father are dragonologists working in India for the colonial government. The children are at first disappointed when they are shipped directly from their boarding school to Dr. Drake's, but the eccentric man introduces them to their first dragons and they're soon hooked on the "science."

***Dragon's Keep* by Janet Carey CAR**

In 1145 A.D., as foretold by Merlin, fourteen-year-old Rosalind, who will be the twenty-first Pendragon Queen of Wilde Island, has much to accomplish to fulfill her destiny, while hiding from her people the dragon's claw she was born with that reflects only one of her mother's dark secrets.

***Dragon's Milk* by Susan Fletcher FLE**

Kaeldra, an outsider adopted by an Elythian family as a baby, possesses the power to understand dragons and uses this power to try to save her younger sister who needs dragon's milk to recover from an illness. Book one

***Dragonsong* by Anne McCaffrey MCC**

Forbidden by her father to indulge in music in any way, a girl on the planet Pern runs away, taking shelter with the planet's fire lizards who, along with her music, opens a new life for her. Book one
