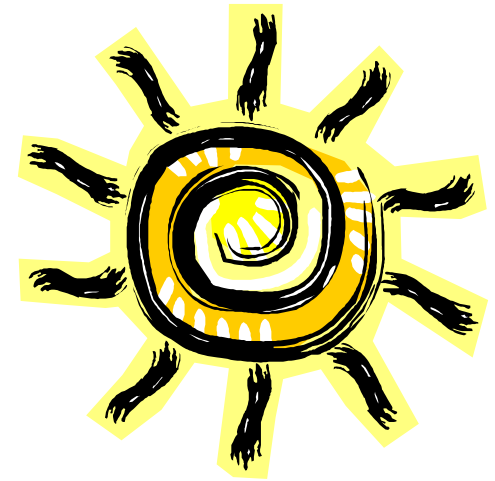

What can your librarian do for you?

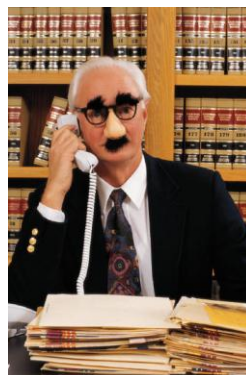
- ☀ Pull carts of books for use in the library or in classrooms.
