Romiette, an African-American girl, and Julio, a Hispanic boy, discover that they attend the same high school after falling in love on the Internet, but are harassed by a gang whose members object to their interracial dating.

Royally Jacked by Nikki Burnham BUR
Valerie's father tells her he's gotten a new job as protocol chief for the royal family of some obscure European country. When she reluctantly joins him, she falls for the prince of the country. Book one.

Son of the Mob by Gordon Korman RKR
Seventeen-year-old Vince's life is constantly complicated by the fact that he is the son of a powerful Mafia boss, a relationship that threatens to destroy his romance with the daughter of an FBI agent. Book one.

Stargirl by Jerry Spinelli SPI
In this story about the perils of popularity, the courage of nonconformity, and the thrill of first love, an eccentric student named Stargirl changes Mica High School forever. Book one.

The Storyteller's Daughter by Cameron Dokey DCR
A retelling of the story of Shahrazad that interweaves fantasy, court intrigue, and romance. Read other books in the Once Upon a Time series.

This Lullaby by Sarah Dessen DES
Raised by a mother who's had five husbands, eighteen-year-old Remy believes in short-term, no-commitment relationships until she meets Dexter, a rock band musician. Read other books by this author.

To Catch a Prince by Gillian McRnight MCR
Stepsisters Alexis Worth and Helen Masterson, both sixteen and in London for the summer, must choose between maintaining their friendship and winning the heart of Prince William.

Twilight by Stephenie Meyer MEY
When seventeen-year-old Bella leaves Phoenix to live with her father in Forks, Washington, she meets an exquisitely handsome boy at school for whom she feels an overwhelming attraction and who she comes to realize is not wholly human. Book one.

Vampire Kisses by Ellen Schreiber SCH
Sixteen-year-old Raven, an outcast who always wears black and hopes to become a vampire some day, falls in love with the mysterious new boy in town, eager to find out if he can make her dreams come true. Book one.

A Walk to Remember by Nicholas Sparks SPA
A romance featuring a troublesome teenager in South Carolina who is changed for the better by the love of a girl. She is the angelic daughter of a local minister, and the boy joins her in doing good deeds. But she has a secret which will break his heart.

Percy and Natalie, Jack's so-called best friends, post an ad in the classified section of the online version of the school newspaper. They figure it couldn't hurt. After all, there's not much in this world sadder than Jack's love life.

Angels Watching Over Me by Lorraine McDaniell MCD
Romance, mystery, and personal problems mingle in this novel about a girl who has bone cancer, the boy she is attracted to in the hospital, and a mysterious nurse. Read other romance books by this author.

Angus, Thongs, and Full-Frontal Snogging by Louise Rennison REN
The humorous journal of a year in the life of a fourteen-year-old British girl who tries to reduce the size of her nose, stop her mad cat from terrorizing the neighborhood animals, and win the love of handsome hunk Robbie. Book one.



Beauty by Robin McKinley MCK
Kind Beauty grows to love the Beast at whose castle she is compelled to stay and through her love releases him from the spell which had turned him from a handsome prince into an ugly beast. Read other books by this author.

Becca's Story by James Forman FCR
A Civil War romance between a Michigan girl and the two soldiers who are rivals for her hand.

Blood and Chocolate by Annette Klause RLA
Having fallen for a human boy, a beautiful teenage werewolf must battle both her pack mates and the fear of the townspeople to decide where she belongs and with whom.

Born Confused by Tanuja Desai Hidier DES
Seventeen-year-old Dimple, whose family is from India, discovers that she is not Indian enough for the Indians and not American enough for the Americans, as she sees her hypnotically beautiful, manipulative best friend taking possession of both her heritage and the boy she likes.

The Changeover: a Supernatural Romance by Margaret Mahy MAH
When her little brother seems to become possessed by an evil spirit, fourteen-year-old Laura seeks the help of the strangely compelling older boy at school who she is convinced has supernatural powers.

Ella Enchanted by Gail Carson Levine LEV
In this novel based on the story of Cinderella, Ella struggles against the childhood curse that forces her to obey any order given to her.

Fancy White Trash by Marjetta Geerling GEE
Fifteen-year-old Abby Savage hopes that her five rules for falling in love will keep her from making the same mistakes as her mother and two older sisters while she also tries to help her best friend Cody admit that he is gay, and decide how she really feels about Cody's older brother, Jackson.

Flipped by Wendelin Van Draanen VAN
In alternating chapters, two teenagers describe how their feelings about themselves, each other, and their families have changed over the years.



I'd Tell You I Love You but Then I'd Have to Kill You by Ally Carter CAR
As a sophomore at a secret spy school and the daughter of a former CIA operative, Cammie is sheltered from "normal teenage life" until she meets a local boy while on a class surveillance mission. Book one.

Just a Summer Romance by Ann Martin MAR
Fourteen-year-old Melanie can't forget the handsome, mysterious boy who was her "summer romance," and when she sees his face on the cover of *People* magazine, she is determined to learn the truth about him.

Memoirs of a Teenage Amnesiac by Gabrielle Zevin ZEV
After a nasty fall, Naomi realizes that she has no memory of the last four years and finds herself reassessing every aspect of her life, including the boys in her life.

Pride and Prejudice by Jane Austen AUS
A spirited young woman copes with the suit of a snobbish gentleman as well as the romantic entanglements of her sisters. Read other romance books by this author.

Princess in Love by Meg Cabot CAB
In a series of humorous diary entries, a New York City ninth grader agonizes over her love life, final exams, and future role as the princess of Genovia. Part of a series.
