SCH**

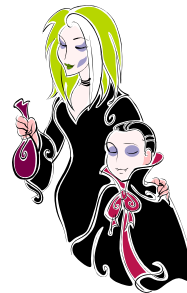

KLA**

Having fallen for a human boy, a beautiful teenage werewolf must battle both her packmates and the fear of the townspeople to decide where she belongs and with whom. Vivian's divided loyalties are strained further when a brutal murder threatens to expose the pack. Moving between two worlds, she does not seem to belong in either.

***The Blooding* by Patricia Windsor

While spending the summer working as an au pair girl for a couple in England, Maris discovers that the husband is a werewolf intent on blooding her and making her one too.

***Bloodline* by Kate Cary
CAR**

In this story told primarily through journal entries, a British soldier in World War I makes the horrifying discovery that his regiment commander is descended from Count Dracula. Book one

***By These Ten Bones* by Clare Dunkle

After a mysterious young wood carver with a horrifying secret arrives in her small Scottish town, Maddie gains his trust—and his heart—and seeks a way to save both him and her townspeople from an ancient evil.

***Cirque du Freak* by Darren Shan
SHA**

Two boys who are best friends visit an illegal freak show, where an encounter with a vampire and a deadly spider forces them to make life-changing choices. Book one

***Dead is the New Black* by Marlene Perez
PER**

While dealing with her first boyfriend and suddenly being pressed into service as a substitute cheerleader, seventeen-year-old Daisy Giordano, daughter and sister of psychics but herself a "normal," attempts to help her mother discover who is behind a series of bizarre attacks on teenage girls in their little town of Nightshade, California. Book one

***Demons of the Ocean* by Justin Somper
SOM**

When twins Connor and Grace's ship is wrecked in a storm and Connor is rescued by pirates, he believes that Grace has been taken aboard the mythical Vampire's ship, and he is determined to find her. Book one

***Eighth Grade Bites* by Heather Brewer
BRE**

For thirteen years Vlad has kept secret that he is half-vampire, but when his missing teacher is replaced by a sinister substitute, he learns that there is more to being a vampire than he could have guessed. Book one

***Evernight* by Claudia Gray
GRA**

Sixteen-year-old Bianca, a new girl at the sinister Evernight Boarding School, finds herself drawn to another outsider, Jared, but dark forces threaten to tear them apart and destroy Bianca's entire world.



***London, 1850* by Sebastian Rook
