Can I take a KCC class and another class at a different site?

Yes, it is possible to take a class at KCC and a class at another site. Transportation to and from summer school is the responsibility of the parent/student.

Infractions that could lead to the loss of credit and being withdrawn from summer school:

- Having more than 3 absences
- Having more than 6 tardies
- Being involved in a fight
- Possession of drugs/alcohol
- Use of drugs/alcohol
- Possession of a weapon
- Found stealing or cheating
- Being truant
- Smoking on campus
- Being uncooperative
- Abusive language
- Disruptive behavior
- Violation of Safety Rules

Depending on the seriousness of the infraction, other consequences may be pursued (for example: expulsion, police involvement).

Grades

Zangle ParentConnect will not be available during Summer School. Final grades will be sent to the registrar at the student's home school. All grades will be available at the student's home school in mid-August.

How can summer school help if I did not pass the HSGQE?

Summer school students who did not pass the HSGQE, or who are at risk of not passing the HSGQE, and who enroll in remedial Language Arts or Math courses will receive specific instruction designed to provide HSGQE success for the student.

What courses are available online this summer?

Students may sign up for Alaska Studies, Government, Critical Reading and Effective Writing or Economics. The MyHigh Course Request form is located on the MyHigh website and must be completed by the student to start the registration process for all online courses in summer school.

Who may attend?

Anchorage School District high school students in grades 8 through 12. Summer school students include those who have a failing course grade, who did not pass any portion of the High School Graduation Qualifying Exam (HSGQE), or who wish to take a course to get ahead and/or to free-up their schedule for more electives in the fall.

Note: Students may attend summer school at the school site that is most convenient for them.

How much credit may be earned?

It is possible to earn .5 credit for each summer school course. Students can complete 2 academic courses and also may earn credit through Work Experience.

How long are the classes?

Each class is 3 hours long each day, 5 days a week.

What is the cost?

\$85 for each class session

How early do I have to wake up?

There is a morning session and an afternoon session. The morning session starts at 8 a.m. and ends at 11 a.m. The afternoon session begins at 11:40 a.m. and ends at 2:40 p.m. (KCC PM session begins at noon and ends at 3:00 p.m.)

How do I register?

1. Determine which class(es) you will take and have your parent/guardian sign the registration form or complete the online Course Request form located on MyHigh website.
2. A parent/guardian signature is required.
3. Take the registration fee, \$85 per course, to your school's Financial Clerk (FDCC). Make checks and money orders payable to *Anchorage School District*.
4. Take the your receipt when meeting with your counselor to go over your completed application. If requesting an online course via MyHigh, your counselor will receive your application after you complete the online Course Request form located on the MyHigh website. Attend Orientation for MyHigh courses either June 8 or 9 at KCC.

Note – If you do not complete the registration process before the regular school year is over, you will still have an opportunity to register at your summer school site on Friday, June 4 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. If you wait until the last day to register, you may not be able to enroll in the class(es) that you need; the classes may full. Classes are subject to consolidation or cancellation due to low enrollment.
