Incoming 9th Graders

Infractions that could lead to the loss of credit and being withdrawn from summer school:

Transcripts and Grades Cards

A transcript of the final grade will be sent to the registrar at your home school. If the student provides a self-addressed, stamped envelope, the final summer school grade(s) will be mailed home after July 27. All grades will be available at the student's home school in September.

How can summer school help if I did not pass the HSGQE?

Summer school students who did not pass the HSGQE, or who are at risk of not passing the HSGQE, and who enroll in remedial Language Arts or Math courses will receive specific instruction designed to provide HSGQE success for the student.

Anchorage School District high school students in grades 8 through 12. Summer school students include incoming 9th graders who wish to take a course to get ahead and/or to free-up their schedule for more electives in the fall.

Note: Students may attend summer school at the school site that is most convenient for them.

How much credit may be earned?

It is possible to earn .5 credit for each summer school course; in some instances, you may be able to complete 2 courses during the summer.

How long are the classes?

Each class is 3 hours long each day, 5 days a week.

What is the cost?

\$85 for each class session

How early do I have to wake up?

There is a morning session and an afternoon session. The morning session starts at 8 a.m. and ends at 11 a.m. The afternoon session begins at 11:40 a.m. and ends at 2:40 p.m. (KCC PM session begins at noon and ends at 3:00 p.m.)

How do I register?

1. Print out this registration form or pick up a printed form from your school counselor.
2. Determine which class(es) you will take and have your parent/guardian sign the registration form.
3. A parent/guardian signature is required.
4. Take the registration fee, \$85 per course, to your school's Stock Clerk (FDCC). Make checks and money orders payable to Anchorage School District.
5. Take the completed registration form to your school.

Note – If you do not complete the registration process before the regular school year is over, you will still have an opportunity to register at your summer school site on Friday, June 5 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. If you wait until the last day to register, you may not be able to enroll in the class(es) that you need; the classes may full. Classes are subject to consolidation or cancellation due to low enrollment.
