The next few questions concern various options for school bonds that may be on the ballot in the April 2002 Municipal Election. The Anchorage School District has identified a list of school renovation and construction projects that partially address the current needs of the District. I would like to describe each of these bonds to you now, and ask you how you think you'd vote on them.

The first bond I'd like you to consider is for \$44 million. This bond would provide \$32 million for districtwide maintenance, including building renewal, roof repairs and replacement, electrical and mechanical upgrades, maintenance equipment and traffic upgrades. It also includes funds for code upgrades at the King Career Center, districtwide sprinkler upgrades, public sewer service for Birchwood Elementary and Chugiak High School, and funds for 10 replacement school buses.

Passing this \$44 million bond would result in an increase in your annual property taxes of approximately \$22 for twenty years for every \$100,000 of assessed property value.

Another possible bond on the ballot is for \$52 million. This bond would provide funds for school design for Bartlett High School and Polaris K12, design and construction funding for Ptarmigan Elementary and for Chugiak, Dimond, East and Service High Schools, and construction funding for Wendler Middle School. The high school and middle school projects on this bond are continuations of phased projects.

Passing this \$52 million bond would result in an increase in your annual property taxes of approximately \$26 for twenty years for every \$100,000 of assessed property value.

2A. If the election was held today, and **both** bonds were on the ballot, do you think you would vote for or against the \$44 million bond, that's the bond we described in the first question?

The bond would be for \$96 million, and would provide \$44 million in maintenance funds for all the schools in the first bond, plus \$52 million in construction funds for all the schools in the second bond. Passing this \$96 million bond would result in an increase in your annual property taxes of approximately \$48 for twenty years for every \$100,000 of assessed property value. If the election was held today, and this was the only school bond on the ballot, do you think you would vote for or against the \$96 million bond?

4. If the school district purchases new school buses, most of the cost of the buses is reimbursed by the State of Alaska. Passing this bond would result in an increase in your annual property taxes, after reimbursement, of approximately 16 cents for seven years for every \$100,000 of assessed property value. If the election was held today, and this bond was on the ballot with the other two, do you think you would vote for or against this bond?

Funding these positions across the district would add approximately \$1.5 million to the school district's budget. Knowing this, if there was an initiative question on the April ballot that asked whether Anchorage high schools should be open-campus, or whether they should be closed-campus, how do you think you would vote?

10A. The School District uses technology in the classroom for instructional purposes and for communication between teachers and parents. The district currently leases computers, but budget restrictions have made it impossible for the district to pursue all phases of its technology plan. The district is considering putting bonds for technology on the April ballot. There are two possible bonds scenarios, and I'd like to know how you think you would vote on each of them.

The first possibility is to fund the district's computer needs with one bond. The total cost of this bond would be \$16.3 million, and it would purchase 13,600 computers for district schools. Passing this \$16.3 million bond would result in an increase in your annual property taxes of approximately \$23 for five years for every \$100,000 of assessed property value. If the election was held today, and this bond was on the ballot along with the two maintenance and construction bonds we discussed earlier, would you vote for or against this bond?

10B. The second possibility is to fund computer technology through a series of bonds. The total cost of this bond would be \$7.3 million this year. Passing this \$7.3 million bond would result in an increase in your annual property taxes of approximately \$10 for five years for every \$100,000 of assessed property value. If the election was held today, and this bond was on the ballot instead of the one we just discussed, would you vote for or against this bond?
