

Gruening Middle School Colts Dress Code 2021 — 2022 School Year

Students at Gruening Middle School are expected to come to school dressed appropriately for a school setting and the ever-changing Alaskan weather.

Some examples of **appropriate** clothing are:

- ★ Clothing that fits properly, is not to too tight, too short, or too baggy
- ★ Sweaters, sweatshirts and fleece are appropriate items to wear inside
- ★ Jeans or pants without large holes (or holes that are 5" above the knee)
- ★ Leggings worn with shirts that come down to mid-hip
- ★ Shorts, dresses, and skirts that are not shorter than 5" above the knee
- ★ Shirts that cover the midriff and back
- ★ Appropriate shoes for indoors/outdoors in various weather conditions

Examples of **inappropriate** clothing are:

- → Outerwear coats, jackets, hats, and gloves should be left in lockers
- → Sunglasses should only be worn outside (unless medically necessary)
- → Pajama bottoms (or anything resembling pajamas) are not allowed
- → Slippers are not appropriate for school in Alaska
- → Leggings and yoga pants must be worn with a long top, past the hips
- → Hats, hoods, headgear and headphones must be removed once indoors
- → Strapless, spaghetti strap, crop, and muscle shirts are inappropriate

Clothing must be free from references to/images of profanity or vulgarity, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or weapons.
