- "Describe your dream bedroom. What would be in it?"
- "Describe a day in your life if you were famous."

- **K-1** Write a list of items around your house that start with each letter of the alphabet. Try putting them in ABC order.
- **2-3** Listen to a book on tape and draw out what you are visualizing about the story.
- **4-5** Find 3 examples of non-fiction writing in your home.

# **Writing**

- **K-1** Practice writing the alphabet in sand, shaving cream, snow, etc., anything you can find. Remember to start your letters at the top.
- **2-3** Write a 3-5 sentence narrative describing your snow day.
