Drop off and Pick up Reminders

Drop off:

School starts at **8:45 am**, <u>students dropped off after 8:45 am will be marked tardy at the desk</u> <u>before going upstairs</u>.

Nurse Corner

A few quick points about ASD Covid-19 policy.

1) ASD is symptom free. Please keep children home with ANY new onset of symptoms. Please do not medicate to hide symptoms, this may make them feel better but does not keep them from being contagious. Students may test for Covid to rule it out and return if fever free without medication for 24 hours prior to returning and symptoms are improving. Negative tests can be emailed to Nurse, or brought in with student.

2) If you are a close contact (within 6 feet for a total of 15 min in 24hours) to someone positive for Covid, you may test right away if you wish, but to return to school, must test 6 days after exposure (last day around positive case is day 0) and if negative and still

asymptomatic on day 8, may return to school while continuing to monitor for symptoms. The virus can take up to 14 days to incubate, most will show up in the first 6 days.3) if positive, isolation is required for 10 days starting the first day of symptoms or a positive test (whichever is first). Must be fever free for 24 hours prior to returning. First day of symptoms or the day you test positive is day 0. students may return on the 11th day.

iReady Diagnostic Newsletter Information 2021/22

Students enrolled in a face-to-face ASD program will take an iReady diagnostic as part of the first two weeks of school. Students will take these diagnostic assessments throughout the school year during the following windows:

Fall: August 17 - September 17 Winter: January 3 - January 21 Spring: May 2 - May 18

Your school will be able to provide the dates your child's classroom will be taking the iReady diagnostic assessments.

Diagnostic Content Assessments by Grade Level

- Reading
 - iReady Grades K-10, Grades 11-12 Tier III Courses
- Mathematics

• iReady - Grades K-8

Diagnostic Purpose

These diagnostic assessments are designed to provide teachers and parents with information about where a student is ready to learn, including areas of strength and areas of concern. It is important to remember that students should take these diagnostic assessments independently. These assessments allow your child's teacher to meet your student exactly where they are and provide data to increase your student's learning gains.

iReady Diagnostic results will be available in Parent Connection the week following the closure of each window.

SAEBRS Information: (Social, Academic, Behavior, Risk, Screener)

This year, our school will be using a screener to look at school-wide systems of support for social-emotional learning and behavior. This screener, much like our academic Universal Screeners (FastBridge and MAP Growth), will be completed with all students in the Fall (September), Winter (December), and Spring (April). Teachers will rate students relative to various behavioral risk factors. The assessment is called the Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavior Risk Screener (SAEBRS). The tool will help teachers identify what additional structures they might need to have in place in their classrooms and as well as identifying students who may need additional supports to increase their academic and social-emotional success. This screening is completed by teachers and will not take away from instructional time nor require input/answers from students.
