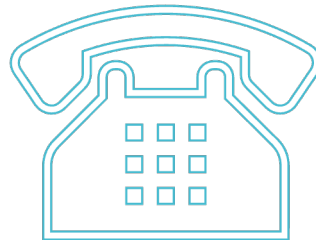

Eagle River High School Credit Tracker

Write the grade earned for each class in its corresponding box. Each box is worth .5 (semester) credit.

English – 4 credits required

Eng I Eng II Eng III (or AP) Eng IV (or AP/Eng elective)

Math – 3 credits required

Algebra Math Elective Math Elective

Science – 3 credits required

Physical Sci Life Sci Sci Elective

Social Studies – 4 credits required

PE – 1.5 credits required

*Each season of a school sport gives a .25 PE Waiver. Two PE waivers are needed to check off one .5 credit box. If PE waivers are used, the same number of boxes will need to be added in the elective rows. PE waivers do not grant credit, but rather waive the PE requirement.

Elective – 7 credits required

If you take more than the required credits for Eng, math, sci, soc, or PE, add those credits to the elective boxes.

ASVAB & Practice SAT/ACT



- ASVAB at ERHS will be Friday, 10/21 and Friday, 2/24
 - ASVAB results give career options that might be a good fit based on your strengths.
 - Starts at 7:30am with interpretation immediately after.
 - Students should plan to be here for about 3 hours.
 - To sign up for the ASVAB, please see Ms. Witte in the Curriculum Office.
- Frontier Tutoring will offer FREE practice SAT and ACT tests virtually
 - Practice ACT - 10/28, 4/9
 - Practice SAT - 11/11, 2/24

- SAT/ACT – Juniors are encouraged to take these tests during the spring of 11th grade.
- Be sure to enter ERHS's code **(020368)** when you sign up for the SAT/ACT. This allows your scores to be sent to the school district. (Required for APS)
- SAT/ACT fee waivers are available to students who qualify for free/reduced lunch. Please contact your counselor for more information.



PSAT /NMSQT Test

Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test

What is it?

The PSAT/NMSQT measures critical reading, math problem solving, and writing skills. The test measures reasoning and critical thinking skills.

Who can take the PSAT/NMSQT?

Sophomore (10th) and Junior (11th) high school students may take the PSAT/NMSQT for practice. The scores of juniors only are considered for the National Merit Scholarship competition.

Why take the PSAT/NMSQT?

1. Performance on critical reading, math and writing can be used to compare a student with other college-bound juniors. If a sophomore takes the test, they are compared with other tenth graders and they are testing strictly for practice.
2. Scores from the PSAT/NMSQT can be used to estimate performance on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT).

How much does the PSAT/NMSQT cost/Who do I pay?

The PSAT test is **\$20.00** for all students. Credit/debit card payments can be made on Parent Connect through Wednesday October 12, 2022 or you can pay cash/check to Mrs. Odens, the cashier, at school through Thursday October 13, 2022. Then fill out this [google form](#) to finish the sign up process.



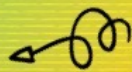

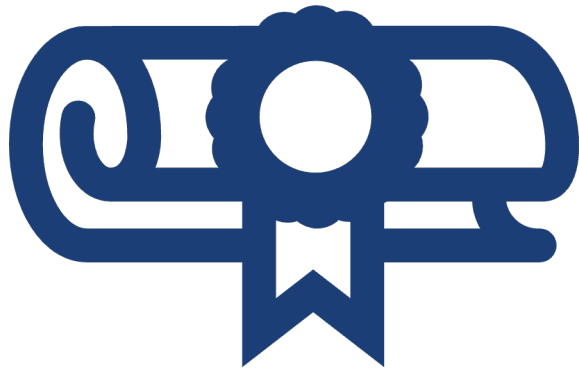
