GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS



Subject	Credits Required
Language Arts	4 credits (8 semesters)
Social Studies	4 credits (8 semesters)
Mathematics	3 credits (6 semesters)
Sciences	3 credits (6 semesters)
PE/Health	1 ½ credits (3 semesters)
Electives	7 credits (14 semesters)
Total	22 ½ credits

Eagle River High School Credit Tracker

Write the grade earned for each class in its corresponding box. Each box is worth .5 (semester) credit.

English – 4 credits required

*Each season of a school sport gives a .25 PE Waiver. Two PE waivers are needed to check off one .5 credit box. If PE waivers are used, the same number of boxes will need to be added in the elective rows. PE waivers do not grant credit, but rather waive the PE requirement.

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Elective – 7 credits required

If you take more than the required credits for Eng, math, sci, soc, or PE, add those credits to the elective boxes.

Remember, as a junior, you must be enrolled in at least five classes per semester, for sports eligibility.

When selecting your classes, consider your plans after high school and scholarship requirements. Be mindful of other commitments. Be careful not to take on too much. Do as much as you can do well.

- A lot of work goes into creating a master schedule. We anticipate the number of sections based on requests.
- Schedule change requests will be considered based on availability for a brief window prior to each semester start.
- Requests will not be accepted for specific teachers or periods.



Online Course Requests - Directions

1. LOG INTO YOUR STUDENT CONNECTION ACCOUNT.
2. IF YOU HAVE TWO TRACKS, SELECT EAGLE RIVER 2025-2026 FOR YOUR MAIN SCHOOL.
3. SELECT THE "REQUESTS" TAB ON THE LEFT SIDE MENU. (DOUBLE CLICK)
4. CLICK THE "ADD/EDIT REQUESTS" ON THE TOP RIGHT SIDE OF THE SECTION.
5. WHEN A COURSE IS SELECTED, THERE WILL BE A COURSE DESCRIPTION TO THE RIGHT. (NOT ALL COURSES WILL HAVE A DESCRIPTION.)
6. SELECT THE COURSE THAT IS YOUR FIRST CHOICE, THEN CLICK "ADD SELECTED CLASS" (REMEMBER THAT THE ORDER YOU SELECT YOUR COURSES WILL DELEGATE THE PRIORITY OF YOUR CHOICES.)
7. CONTINUE WITH STEP 6 UNTIL YOU HAVE ENTERED ALL OF YOUR CHOICES IN ORDER THEN CLICK THE "SUBMIT" BUTTON AT THE TOP OF THE WINDOW.
8. YOU WILL ONLY BE ABLE TO MAKE CHANGES TO YOUR REQUESTS DURING THE OPEN REGISTRATION WINDOW, SHOWN ON PREVIOUS SLIDE.
