

Online Course Requests - Directions

1. LOG INTO YOUR STUDENT CONNECTION ACCOUNT.
2. ALL COURSE SELECTIONS WILL BE MADE IN THE **EAGLE RIVER 2025-2026** TRACK, YOUR MAIN SCHOOL, REGARDLESS OF OTHER SCHOOL TRACKS YOU MAY SEE ON YOUR PROFILE.
3. SELECT THE "REQUESTS" TAB ON THE LEFT SIDE MENU.
4. CLICK "ADD/EDIT REQUESTS" ON THE TOP RIGHT SIDE OF THE SECTION.
5. WHEN A COURSE IS SELECTED, THERE WILL BE A COURSE DESCRIPTION TO THE RIGHT (NOT ALL COURSES WILL HAVE A DESCRIPTION, PLEASE REFER TO THE ASD PROGRAM OF STUDIES FOR MORE INFORMATION.)
6. SELECT THE COURSE THAT IS YOUR FIRST CHOICE, THEN CLICK "ADD SELECTED CLASS"
(REMEMBER THAT THE ORDER IN WHICH YOU SELECT CLASSES WILL DELEGATE THE PRIORITY OF YOUR CHOICES.)
7. YOU WILL NEED TO ADD YOUR CORE CLASSES (ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES, & 2 ELECTIVE CLASSES.) WHEN SELECTING ALTERNATE COURSES FOR ANY/ALL OF YOUR COURSES, PLEASE USE THE ALTERNATE COURSE OPTION.
8. CONTINUE WITH STEPS #6 & #7 UNTIL YOU HAVE ENTERED ALL YOUR CHOICES & ALTERNATES IN ORDER THEN CLICK "**SUBMIT**" AT THE TOP OF THE WINDOW.
