Alaska Performance Scholarship Notification

The Alaska Performance Scholarship (APS) provides an opportunity for Alaska high school students to earn a scholarship to help cover the cost of an Alaska postsecondary education.

Eligibility requirements for APS include:

- Alaska residents who graduate from an Alaska high school (including homeschool)
- Take a rigorous curriculum,
- Earn minimum of 2.5 GPA OR meet qualifying score on college/career entrance exam (SAT, ACT, WorkKeys)
- The APS can be used at any participating college or university in Alaska, or for approved career and technical education programs in the state.

Students should work with their school counselor to create a schedule that prepares them for APS coursework that starts in 9th grade.

- 1. Make a plan to complete the APS curriculum with your high school counselor. Review this plan EVERY YEAR for required courses needed.
- 2. Start with the checklist for your class year (attached)
- 3. Work to achieve the highest GPA you can.

Students' APS-eligible courses are available to view in Parent Connect and Student Connect under APS Information.
