****Internet Connection Types Defined:**

- Fiber – Fiber-optic line running to your house providing internet.
- Cable – Internet comes through a coaxial cable from an internet provider.
- DSL – Digital Subscriber Line modem. DSL modem plugs into a phone jack but doesn't prevent you from using the phone and the internet at the same time.
- Microwave – There is a microwave receiver in your house that picks up your internet over a microwave broadcast.
- Satellite – Internet is provided from a satellite dish.
- Dial-Up – A Dial-Up modem that plugs into the phone jack and prevents you from using your home phone whenever you are using the internet.
- Personal Hotspot/Smartphone – Using a Smartphone as your only source of internet, or using it to transmit WiFi to other devices.
- School-Provided Hotspot – Using WiFi that is transmitted from a school building or a school vehicle to access the internet.
