
# Matricula en Línea en Conexión para Padres

#### **ASD Quick Links**


Haga clic en el **signo más** junto a **ASD Quick links** para expandir esta sección, luego seleccione **Online Registration (Matrícula en Línea).** 






## **Pantalla Principal**

Seleccione el botón verde **Register (Matricular)** que aparece al lado del estudiante que desea matricular. (Nota: después de que un estudiante haya sido matriculado, el botón verde register cambia a **Registered**-Matriculado).




#### Pantalla Información del Estudiante


## Pantalla de Editar el Contacto Principal

Solamente para editar **contactos principales (padres/guardianes)**, no para contactos de emergencia. (Nota: Debe haber una dirección de trabajo en la lista a menos que la casilla **No Employment** [Sin empleo] esté marcada).



#### Contactos de Emergencia

Los contactos de emergencia son personas distintas al padre/guardián. No ponga un contacto principal como contacto de emergencia. Los contactos principales siempre se llaman primero.



#### Pantallas de Acuerdos


Este tipo de pantalla puede variar según el grado y la escuela. Vea algunos ejemplos a continuación.



#### Internet Agreement

We are pleased to offer students in the Anchorage School District access to the District computer network for Internet access. To obtain Internet access, all students must have parental permission.

Access to the Internet will enable students to explore thousands of libraries, databases, and bulletin boards while exchanging messages with Internet users throughout the world. Families should be aware that some material accessible via the Internet may contain items that are illegal, defamatory, inaccurate or potentially offensive. While our intent is to make Internet access available to further educational goals and objectives, students may find ways to access other materials as well. We believe that the benefits to students from access to the Internet, in the form of information resources and opportunities for collaboration, exceed any disadvantages. But ultimately, parents and guardians of minors are responsible for setting and conveying the standards that their children should follow when using media and information sources.



### Release of Student Directory Information: K-12

As a parent (or a student 18 or over), you have the right to prohibit the Release of Student Directory Information about your student.

#### What is Student Directory Information?

"Student Directory Information" is information about students that may be disclosed by the Anchorage School District (ASD) to identify enrollment and to publicize student accomplishments and activities. Examples of publication include:

- \* The annual yearbook
- \* A playbill showing your student's role in a drama production
- \* Graduation programs \* Honor roll or other recognition lists
- \* Sports activity sheets, such as for wrestling, showing weight and height of team members

## Library Card Consent

Anchorage Public Library (APL) in partnership with the Anchorage School District will give parents/guardians the choice to get a public library access number for their student when they register for school in the Anchorage School District (ASD). The ASD will provide this opportunity to all ASD K-12 students through the ASD online registration process. This consent must be reauthorized annually. The ASD library number will serve as the APL library access number.


