## What is a problem statement?

Adapted from an <u>article by Alan Bryman in</u> <u>the International Journal of Social Research</u> <u>Methodology</u>: A problem is a statement about an area of concern, a condition to be improved upon, a difficulty to be eliminated, or a troubling question that exists in theory or in practice that points to the need for meaningful understanding and deliberate investigation.



## **Elements of a problem statement**

Key elements of an effective problem statement include:

- Gap: Identify the gap (pain) that exists today.
- Timeframe, location and trend: Describe when and where the problem was first observed and what kind of trend it is following.
- **Impact**: Quantify the gap (cost, time, quality, environmental, personal, etc.)
- **Importance**: To the organization, the individual, etc. to better understand the urgency.



## An example
