IMMUNIZATION (SHOT) CLINICS**

The best place for your child to receive vaccinations is at his/her pediatrician's office or medical home. If his/her provider is not able to see your child to get the shots, or you do not have a medical home, the places listed are a sample list of providers. **Please call clinics first as information may have changed since the list was compiled.**

Due to COVID-19- face covering is required and one person to accompany the child only.

In addition to the places listed above, many retail pharmacies such as Fred Meyer, Carrs/Safeway, Walgreens, Costco, etc., have vaccine available. Call ahead before taking your child to one of these locations to be sure they have the right vaccine available.

Process for some of the clinics- Face covering is required and only child or children getting immunizations allowed into clinic with one (1) caregiver. Upon arrival, obtain packet of paper work and get onto waiting list. Return to car, fill out paper work, and await phone call from clinic to come up.

After your child receives his/her vaccinations, please get the paperwork to the school nurse.
