Introduction

The School Resource Officer Unit reflects a nationally accepted program that places law enforcement officers within local schools. The unit was designed to develop partnerships between law enforcement and the school community.

The aim is to provide a positive law enforcement influence that concentrates on safety and security; encourages relationships between officers, school administrators, teachers and students; and fosters education.

Goals

- To be a visible, active law enforcement figure on campus who is an immediate first responder, dealing with any law-related issues.
