We are pleased to inform you Wonder Park will be participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (C.E.P.) program for the 2019-2020 School Year. The CEP program is part of the National School Lunch and Special Breakfast Programs families to access free healthy breakfasts and lunches.

All enrolled students at Wonder Park are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to you or your household, every day of the 2019-2020 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) at Wonder Park will be able to participate without having to pay a fee or submit a meal application.

This program includes a full meal. Second meals, a la carte meals or a la carte milk are not covered under the program.

If your child(ren) changes schools during the school year to a non-CEP school, you will need to apply for our free and reduced lunch program to see if you qualify for continued benefits. Applications are available online at <https://asdk12.org/studentnutrition>
