

PROPOSITION 1



Security and **Safety Upgrades**

The 2023 School Bond proposition will support schools across Anchorage with security and safety upgrades. A quality school's functional life, without major renewal, ranges from 30 to 50 years. However, for ASD's schools—many built in the 1960s and 1970s, additional funds beyond the maintenance budget are occasionally required.

Projects on the bond include:

- Prioritized Security Vestibule and Security Upgrades
- Academic Area Safety Upgrades
- Roof Replacement and Roof Upgrades






