Withdrawal Deadline

If an AMCS student is in jeopardy of not passing a UAA class, and they have <u>exhausted all possible options</u> to complete the class successfully, they have the option to withdraw from the class by the UAA withdrawal deadline, **November 3, 2023, by 5 PM**.

AMCS students who choose to withdraw from a UAA course <u>must</u> complete the College Course Grade Change Form with their UAA advisor before they can withdraw from the UAA class in UAOnline. The withdrawal form helps to ensure that the AMCS high school staff and UAA Middle College staff are aware of this decision and provide feedback to the student if necessary.

Registrar's Range

Register Now: The Anchorage School District **requires** all students to be registered every year through ASD Parent Connection: Once you have logged in, look for QuickLinks on the left and click on your student's picture. Information on how to reset your PIN and password is found here also.

In Parent Connection you can **update your contact information**, view your student's unofficial transcripts, demographic data, class schedule, attendance, pay for lunches and activities, and muchmore!

ASD must verify address changes, please send proof of residency to Elizabeth Goetz, AMCS Registrar, goetz_elizabeth@asdk12.org.

- This document must show the <u>service address</u>: Utility bill, Lease/Rental Agreement, Mortgage Document, Military Housing, etc.
- Phone bills, credit cards, or bank statements are **not** accepted.

<u>Transcript Requests:</u> The Anchorage School District uses <u>ScribOrder</u> for all educational records requests. If you are under the age of 18, a parent/guardian must be the one to submit the request. Be sure to have them legibly signed. We can send e-documents to most post-secondary institutions, so please enter this information in your request. Sending e-documents gets your transcripts to the schools much sooner than mailing them, and it saves everybody time!

Part-time course enrollment forms are due by **December 15**.

<u>Credit by Choice</u>: Credit by Choice Applications have to be filled out prior to or at the beginning of the semester. They will not be accepted after you have completed the course. Credit By Choice.

<u>Letter of Recommendation:</u> It is <u>Letter of Recommendation</u> time! I love writing personalized letters; please complete the form and email it to me.

<u>Alaska Performance Scholarship:</u> I will send out information about the Alaska Performance Scholarship in October as we schedule your Spring courses. Please check out the APS checklist and see if you are on target to earn this award, the <u>APS website</u>.

Midterm Progress Report

Midterm progress reports are due in a digital format that requires a student to upload a picture of each of their BlackBoard and/or UAOnline grades, upload a TITLE IX certificate of completion, add their remaining high school graduation requirements (after fall semester), see how their UAA courses apply to a future degree or GERs by completing a degree audit in DegreeWorks, and propose UAA courses for the spring.

Current grades should be available in BlackBoard and/or UAOnline, and should be submitted between October 13 and October 30, 2023. If grades are missing, students should reach out directly to their professor.

Middle College Spring Advising

Midterm progress reports & Title IX <u>must</u> be complete to schedule an advising appointment. If students schedule an advising appointment with an incomplete progress report, <u>their appointment will be cancelled</u>. Advising appointments begin Monday, October 30.

TITLE IX

Students who still need to complete their <u>TITLE IX Training</u>, can access it at <u>BlackBoard Online Training</u>. There will be a Certificate of Completion that can be submitted with midterm grades. Students do not need to submit TITLE IX if they attended the Zoom training.

Withdrawal Deadline

If an AMCS student is in jeopardy of not passing a UAA course with a C or better, and they have talked to the professor and exhausted all options to complete the course successfully, it is possible to withdraw. Withdrawing from a college course can impact <u>Satisfactory Academic Performance and future financial</u> aid.

AMCS students who choose to withdraw from a UAA course must complete the College Course Grade Change Form with their UAA advisor before they can withdraw from the UAA class in UAOnline. The withdrawal form helps to ensure that the AMCS high school counselor and UAA Middle College staff are aware of the decision and the possible impact to high school graduation. This DocuSign requires a student's explanation and signature, Ms. Sherwood's signature, a parent/guardian's signature, and a UAA advisor's signature. UAA withdrawal deadline is 5PM on November 3, 2023.



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
