Dear Bowman Families:

The 2023-2024 school year is off and running. Seeing new and returning families during our Back-to-School Open House, Optional Program Open Houses, the first day of school, and around the school these last few weeks was great to witness. Our current student enrollment is 569. I look forward to a great school year with your children; it will be exciting!



Bowman has a great office staff consisting of our Administrative Assistant **Bright Nygard**, and School Secretary **Doreen Joyner**. Moving into the new school year, this is a friendly reminder about the **ASD Attendance Policy**. The district continues with the goal of "Every student will attend school at least 90% of the time." Below is information on what absences and tardies are defined as in elementary. To reach 90% attendance, the following procedures are in place:

FIVE conditions may result in an excused absence from school:

- 1. Illness
- 2. Death or severe illness in the immediate family
- 3. Participation in a school function
- 4. Extenuating circumstances approved by the principal, and
- 5. Attendance at religious service

<u>Parents must call the</u> **Bowman at 742-5600 by 9:00 a.m.** <u>regarding their child's non-attendance or</u> <u>late arrival</u>. By 11:00 a.m., a "robocall" will go out to the primary contact number for unexcused students. For any other information regarding your child, you would like to send to the office, please email Bright or Doreen at <u>bowmanoffice@asdk12.org</u>.

This is our first newsletter of the 2023-2024 school year. We will send the newsletter through email, the website, and connected to the ASD app once a month. Please ensure you have an updated email address on file in the office, as this address will be the one to which the newsletter and other information is sent. mClass Newsletter Information

2023 - 2024

As part of The Alaska Reads Act, the State of Alaska requires that districts administer an early literacy screening tool three times a year to students in grades K-3 to identify potential reading difficulties in order to improve reading outcomes for students. Families can read more about this comprehensive K-3 reading policy at The Alaska Reads Act website: education.alaska.gov/akreads

mClass with DIBELS 8th Edition Assessments is the State of Alaska Department of Education's and ASD's Early Literacy benchmark screening and progress monitoring tool for students in grades K-3 in reading. mClass utilizes curriculum-based measures and is used by schools as part of the ASD Comprehensive Assessment System to support informed instructional decisions.

Nurse News

Hello Bowman Families & welcome back! NO shots, No school is ASD's policy. Alaska Immunization Regulations 7 AAC 57.550 and 4AAC 06.055 require that all children in Alaska public/private schools & childcare facilities be immunized unless he/she is exempted or immune.

Please have your child's immunizations updated as soon as possible. If you choose not to immunize your child, you have the option to file an exemption with the school. This form needs to be notarized and updated each school year. Personal or philosophical exemptions are not allowed per state law. You can email or fax updated records to me. State school screening will be taking place this & next month, remember to send your children with their glasses.

No medication is allowed in your child's backpack or lunch box. If your child needs medication during the school day; this includes all over-the-counter medications. If you have any questions, please contact me. Thank you!

A MUSIC NOTES

I am excited to start another fun year at Bowman and share with the students some of the new books and musical activities that I learned at music workshops over the last year! At Bowman, my goal is to find a way for students to appreciate and find a love for music. I also work with students to help them gain music reading and ensemble skills that can be continued outside of an elementary

classroom. Music provides students the opportunity to express themselves through movement, speech, and play. In our classroom at Bowman, an Orff-Schulwerk approach is used for teaching children. Through an Orff approach students learn music through what they instinctively do: play, imitation, experimentation, and personal expression. Encourage your students to share with you what we are doing in class!

Bowman Bobcat Choir:

Choir rehearsals begin on Tuesday, September 12th!

The choir rehearses on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings from 7:50 - 8:50 am in the music room. The Bowman choir is geared for students in 3rd - 6th grade. Families who signed up for choir have already received an email about choir upcoming choir rehearsals!

Recorder:

4th and 5th grade students in Davis's, Jones's, Lara's, Kari's, Cannon's, Ely's, and Syke's class are learning how to play the recorder this year! Recorder helps students prepare for more complex instruments in 6th grade band and orchestra. Recorder is also a great instrument for introducing how to read music on the treble clef staff. At Bowman we have classroom sets of recorders. Each student has one assigned to them for the school year. Each recorder is kept in their own case and stored in between classes. A letter will be sent out to classes soon about the option of purchasing their own recorder.

Health Happenings...

Dear Families,

This letter is to let you know that your child's class will be receiving age-appropriate lessons on child sexual abuse and assault prevention education as required under the state's <u>Alaska Safe</u> <u>Children's Act</u> (<u>Erin's Law</u>). Erin's Law Education is comprised of two lessons (one lesson at the beginning of each semester) taught during the Health classes. Combined, these lessons meet the full requirements for students under the <u>Alaska Safe Children's Act</u> (<u>Erin's Law</u>) and are designed to help prevent childhood sexual abuse. These lessons will be presented in a non-threatening way,



along with the skills needed for self-protection and will be handled in a sensitive, respectful manner.
