








Nurse Laura's List

Dear Sand Lake Families.

ASD has made it possible for me to perform COVID testing here at Sand Lake Elementary. I am now able to complete testing for those who become sick at school and need to go home.

COVID testing is not done because we "think" a symptom is due to COVID-19, it is done so that we know it is not COVID-19 so we can avoid exposing others. Please continue to follow the ASD protocol for any of the below symptoms.

Fever. chills, new trouble breathing or shortness of breath, new cough, diarrhea, abdominal pain, vomiting, fatigue, joint pain, muscle aches or body aches, new rash, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, headache, new congestion, new runny nose.

Patient Registration for ASD Covid Testing Program--Instructions

If on a chromebook, click on the camera icon on the lower toolbar. Open the camera and take a picture of:

- 1. The back and front of your insurance card
- 2. The back and front of your driver's license
- 3. The floor or the ceiling--yes, the floor or the ceiling

Click "I don't have a QR-Code"

Click "Next"--if a new screen does not appear then scroll up and look for red areas that show required fields. Fill those out.

Test Consent

Click "Yes, I am electronically signing my approval and consent to proceed"

If signing for yourself as a patient, click "The Patient"

If signing as a parent or guardian click "That Patient's legally Authorized Representative.

Then enter your name and the name of the witness

Next--if a new screen does not appear then scroll up and look for red areas that show required fields. Fill those out.

Personal Information

Enter the personal information of the person getting tested for Covid

Check the "Text/SMS" box under the personal data fields to get your results via text

Social Security Number is not required

If you would like your test result electronically attached to your passport, click "yes"--this is helpful for international travel. It will require you to enter your passport number. If not traveling, click "no"

Enter ethnicity and race information for person being tested

Click "Next"--if a new screen does not appear then scroll up and look for red areas that show required fields. Fill those out.

Do you have insurance?

Click "yes"--this will require you to enter insurance information. Have your card handy.

Click "no" --enter your State ID or license number

OR

If you don't want to enter this, then enter "99999"

Social Security Number--not required

Answer the medical questions

Next--if a new screen does not appear then scroll up and look for red areas that show required fields. Fill those out.

Your personal QR code is now created. It will be on file in the system

Cheats:

- Only answer the required questions--those marked with an *
- If you do not want to enter an insurance # or state id #, enter "999999"
- If you do not want to enter a picture of your insurance card or driver's license, upload the picture of the floor or ceiling that you took at the beginning of this process


